Category	Education/Experience
Jr. Engineer	Bachelor’s degrees from an accredited college in a related discipline, or equivalent experience/combined education. Although this is an entry level position the employee must have a minimum 1 years of experience.
Engineer	Bachelor’s degrees from an accredited college in a related discipline, or equivalent experience/combined education, with 5+ years of professional experience; or 3 years of professional experience with a related Masters degree.
Sr. Engineer	Bachelor’s degrees from an accredited college in a related discipline, or equivalent experience/combined education, with 10+ years of professional experience; or 8 years of professional experience with a related Master’s degree.
