Information Specialist II

Minimum/General Experience: a minimum of 1 year of general experience

Functional Responsibility: Plans, designs, implements, and maintains computer and management information systems and/or designs, develops, codes, debugs, and maintains software programs

Minimum Education: Bachelor's degree or equivalent. An additional 5 years experience may be substituted for the degree requirement.

Information Specialist III

Minimum/General Experience: a minimum of 3 years of general experience

Functional Responsibility: Plans, designs, implements, and maintains lead and management information systems and/or designs, develops, codes, debugs, and maintains software programs

Minimum Education: Bachelor's degree or equivalent. An additional 5 years experience may be substituted for the degree requirement

Information Specialist IV

Minimum/General Experience: a minimum of 5 years of general experience.

Functional Responsibility: Plans, designs, implements, and maintains computer and management information systems and/or designs, develops, codes, debugs, and maintains software programs

Minimum Education: Bachelor's degree or equivalent. An additional 5 years experience may be substituted for the degree requirement. An advanced degree may be substituted for 3 years of experience.

Information Specialist V

Minimum/General Experience: a minimum of 10 years of general experience

Functional Responsibility: Plans, designs, implements, and maintains computer and management information systems and/or designs, develops, codes, debugs, and maintains software programs

Minimum Education: Bachelor's degree or equivalent. An additional 5 years experience may be substituted for the degree requirement. An advanced degree may be substituted for 5 years of experience.

Sr. Electrical/Control

Minimum/General Experience: 8 years experience in electrical/controls engineering design, analysis, fabrication, and testing.

Functional Responsibility: Electrical and control system design, analysis, configuration, fabrication assistance, and test. May provide documentation and configuration management of specified electrical and control system hardware and software development. Task order management, including budget and schedule definition and control.

Minimum Education: BSEE

Engineer Specialist Level II

Minimum/General Experience: 12 years experience in any combination of aerospace engineering, mechanical engineering, electrical engineering, controls engineering, or systems engineering.

Functional Responsibility: Provides unique system design, analysis, performance evaluation, or system integration support that exceeds the standards set for senior level design and senior level systems engineering positions. Substantial experience in the use of applicable finite element analysis, model-based systems engineering, or dynamic system performance analysis tools is required for candidates who will be assigned to related tasks.

Minimum Education: BSME, BSEE, BSCS, or BSAE.

Systems Engineer

Minimum/General Experience: 1 year experience in engineering design and/or analysis associated with aerospace engineering, mechanical engineering, electrical/electronic engineering, controls engineering, or IT disciplines. Minimum/General Experience: 15 years experience of defense/industrial or acquisition experience in the field of expertise

Functional Responsibility: Serves as a senior advisor/analyst that has acknowledged specialized acquisition, logistics, technical and/or business expertise in the specific functional tasks required for performance in an individual task order. May serve as the project software for either a contract or task. May serve as the primary customer point of contact for an

Minimum Education: Master or Doctorate degree in either a technical, business, or management area or a Bachelor's degree in an engineering or related technical field. Bachelor degree with an additional 3 years of applicable experience may be substituted for the degree requirement.
