Minimum/General Experience: Five years of field experience with some actual installation experience. Understanding of AV integration with IP technologies a must. Videoconferencing experience a must.

Functional Responsibility: Design and integrate equipment for audiovisual applications.

Minimum Education: Four years of college with concentration in electrical engineering and design. Must have complete knowledge of AutoCad. Must have industrial certifications through ICIA and complete knowledge of equipment in industry.

Project Manager
