G U A R D I :

Guard I is an unarmed guard that performs various duties depending on a clients needs. The duties could be as basic as check the ID's of employees entering an office or plant and as complex as making rounds of a facility by checking heating and refrigeration systems to be sure they are functioning properly. Other duties involve security breaches and emergencies as outlined in guard post orders.

A Guard I has to be licensed in most states and receive specialized security training from the area state police. This training is extensive and must be completed before we can employ an individual as a guard with our company. This training includes the following subjects: orientation, rules and regulations, legal limitations, use of force, ethics, multicultural diversity/awareness, report writing and communications.

In addition, training is provided in-house and in some ways may duplicate state police training. It includes the following: post orientation, report writing, uniform and equipment, patrolling and basic supervision. Each Guard I also receives site-specific training at the client's facilities.

A client may require more experience depending on the nature of the assignment but generally a Guard I does not require experience if he/she completes the initial training successfully. He/she is required at the minimum to have a high school diploma or its equivalent, a valid driver's license and a clean criminal record.

27102: GUARD II:

Guard II is an armed guard and performs similar duties to a Guard I except a Guard II is assigned to higher risk and sensitive sites. Guard II generally is in sites where money is handled, or in government offices such as the Social Security Administration offices, Department of Homeland Security buildings, etc. They are often used in county Domestic Relations offices and local public housing complexes.

A Guard II also has to be licensed in most states and receive specialized security training from the area state police. This training is extensive and must be completed before we can employ an individual as a guard with our company. This training includes the following subjects: orientation, rules and regulations, legal limitations, use of force, ethics, multicultural diversity/awareness, report writing and communications. Additional training is provided in-house and in some ways may duplicate state police training and includes the following: post orientation, report writing, uniform and equipment, patrolling and basic supervision. Each Guard II also receives site-specific training at the client's facilities.

A client may require more experience depending on the nature of the assignment but generally a Guard II does not require experience if he/she completes the initial training successfully. They are required at the minimum to have a high school diploma or its equivalent, a valid driver's license, and a clean criminal record. He/she is certified by local police departments and must demonstrate appropriate and continuous proficiency if he/she uses a fire arm.
