Project Manager

Responsibilities: On call 24/7 to respond quickly to client requests or concerns. Develops and manages high-impact physical security programs. Range of duties include ensuring smooth account startup/transitions; monitoring contract compliance; performing management audits of field operations; designing and delivering customized training solutions; scheduling personnel; managing billing, payroll, and expense aspects of customer accounts. The Project Manager ensures compliance with federal, state, and local laws/regulations; compliance with customer policies, procedures, and post orders; and with Summit policies and procedures, effectively maintaining tight management of security outcomes at client facilities.

Experience: Minimum 5 years of security services experience.

Qualifications: Proven, credentialed security professional. Extensive knowledge of physical security operations and advanced customer service skills. Current State Security Officer license/registration.

Training: Leadership skills training. Receives ongoing training through industry seminars and learning opportunities presented by professional security, law enforcement and investigative associations. Additional high-level training as needed in terrorism response, report writing, OSHA Compliance, enhanced communications, high-rise building security, diversity awareness and sexual harassment, and response to workplace violence.

Also include entry level undercover operations, background investigations, asset searches, and standard investigative functions.

Experience: Minimum of three (3) years full-time experience in an investigative position with a public or private organization. One (1) year of undergraduate study or military service can be substituted for each year of experience required, for a maximum of three (3) years.

Qualifications/Educations: Investigators must pass a thorough background investigation, which includes drug screening. Investigators must be properly licensed and have any required training under the laws of the jurisdiction in which the investigation is conducted. Must have a general knowledge and understanding of basic investigative techniques such as methods for conducting surveillance, knowledge of the Law as it pertains to Private Investigators, knowledge of legal restrictions for private investigation, evidence collection, storage, chain of custody, investigative report writing, and standard investigative functions. Must possess basic computer operating skills in order to prepare reports, send and receive e-mail, access and search the internet.

Investigator Level II

Responsibilities: Level 2 Investigators will meet all of the criteria of a Level 1 Investigator and, in addition, have a minimum of five (5) years' experience in the investigative field, conducting more complex investigations, such as fraud investigations, fraud waste and abuse research, video surveillance, complex interviews and interrogation, individual background inquiries, due diligence investigations, and investigative report preparation and submittal. Additional responsibilities can include employee allegations of misconduct, including mismanagement and disciplinary actions and administrative fact finding investigations. Well-versed in report writing, as well as the ability to give testimony at hearings, trials, and grand juries and conduct in-depth, complex investigations from start to completion. In addition, Level

II Investigators may have a specialized area of expertise such as healthcare fraud detection, financial fraud detection, arson investigations, accident reconstruction, specialized language skill, covert investigative monitoring, intelligence analysis or other specialized investigative function.

Experience: Level 2 Investigators must have a minimum of five (5) years investigative experience in an organized law enforcement, military and/or private sector discipline. One (1) year of undergraduate study, may be substituted for one (1) year of investigative experience to a maximum of four (4) years.

Qualifications/Educations: Level 2 Investigators must possess knowledge of all Federal, State, and Local laws as they apply to conducting legal investigations within the jurisdictions that they conduct their investigations. Investigators must be thoroughly familiar with all disciplines of basic and advanced investigative techniques, including video surveillance, technical surveillance, interview and interrogation techniques, taking statements, undercover work, report writing, and verbal communication skills. Must possess basic computer operating skills in order to prepare reports, send and receive e-mail, and access and search the internet.

Investigator Level III (Specialized)

Responsibilities: Level 3 Special Investigators must have a specialized background in a professional field, skill, license and/or certification that can be used in an investigation to enhance the investigation result. Examples of special backgrounds, skills, licenses and certifications are: Medical Doctor, Certified Medical Chart Reviewer, Certified Medical Billing Coder, Pharmacist, Nurse, Attorney, Certified Public Accountant (CPA), Court Certified Interrupters, Court Certified Expert Witness, Handwriting Analyst, Document Examiner, Technical Surveillance Counter Measures Technician (TSCM/Electronic Sweep Technician), Forensic Analyst, Computer Forensics Analyst, Polygraph Examiner, and Secret or Top Secret Cleared Investigators.

Experience: Must have at least three (3) years' experience in their respective fields of expertise.

Qualifications/Educations: Must meet all the qualifications, certifications and education requirements of their respective backgrounds and be licensed or certified in their field for at least three (3) years.

Security / Risk Assessment Consultant

Responsibilities: Conducts advanced surveys to provide the necessary intelligence to initiate defensive maneuvers against potential threats. Gathers information and evidence required to determine vulnerabilities and protection needs through a combination of investigative skills, corroboration, and protective intelligence. Provides comprehensive interior and exterior physical security risk assessments for facilities of all types, locating all potential hazards and security breaches. Provides fully documented and photographed reports of security recommendations.

Experience: Minimum 10 years of Law Enforcement Experience or 5 years of Military Experience.

Qualifications: Expertise in special events, including media events, large corporate and university gatherings, international sporting events, conferences, and major political events. Consultants are former and off-duty law enforcement officers and military professionals with distinguished federal, state, county, and local agency service records. All Consultants exceed the highest standards of professional expertise, integrity, character, and physical and mental fitness. All Consultants have the critical skills to include intelligence gathering, information technology, operations, logistics, planning, defensive tactics, surveillance, counter-surveillance and detection capabilities

Training: Law Enforcement or Military Training. Advanced Risk and Threat Assessment Training.

Education: High School Diploma. Law Enforcement or Military Education.

Guard I (SCA code 27101)

Responsibility: Carries out instructions primarily oriented toward insuring that emergencies and security violations are readily discovered and reported to appropriate authority. Intervenes directly only in situations which require minimal action to safeguard property or persons. Duties require minimal training.

Experience: 21 years of age; Entry Level

Education: High school diploma or GED plus completion of a certified security training program or local, state or federal law enforcement training academy.

Guard II (SCA code 27102)

Responsibility: Enforces regulations designed to prevent breaches of security. Exercises judgment and use discretion in dealing with whether first response should be to intervene directly (asking for assistance when deemed necessary and time allows), to keep situation under surveillance, or to report situation so that it can be handled by appropriate authority. Duties require specialized training in methods and techniques of protecting security areas. Commonly, the guard is required to demonstrate continuing physical and proficiency with firearms or other special weapons.

Experience: 21 years of age; one (1) year of guard experience.

Education: High school diploma or GED plus completion of a certified security training program or local, state or federal law enforcement training academy.

Alarm Monitor (SCA code 27004)

Responsibilities: Operates communication equipment to receive incoming calls for assistance and dispatches personnel and equipment to scene of emergency. Operates telephone console to receive incoming calls for assistance. Questions caller to determine nature of problem and type and number of personnel and equipment needed, following established guidelines. Scans status charts and computer screen to determine units available. Monitors alarm system signals that indicate location of fire or other emergency. Operates two-way radio to dispatch police, fire, medical, and other personnel and equipment and to relay instructions or information to remove units. Types commands on computer keyboard to update files and maintain logs. Tests communications and alarm equipment and backup systems to ensure serviceability. May provide pre-arrival instructions to caller, utilizing knowledge of emergency medical techniques. May activate alarm system to notify fire stations.

Experience: 21 years of age with minimum 3 years of Security Experience, preferably in a position requiring customer contact and communications skills.

Qualifications: Current State Security Officer license/registration; demonstrated line security excellence; excellent customer service and communications skills. Ability to synthesize information from multiple, diverse and simultaneous inputs. Knowledge of personal computers and software, with a particular emphasis on Graphical User Interface applications, e.g., Microsoft Windows, MS Office.

Fire Safety Director (SCA code 27070)

Responsibilities: Serves facilities requiring enhanced fire safety protection, particularly where required by local building and safety codes. Protects people, property and/or assets by performing a combination of duties. In addition to the duties expected of Uniformed Security Officer I or II (Unarmed), responsibilities include implementing the building Fire Safety Plan; supervising/staffing the Fire Command Station; liaising with and advising the fire department during emergency operations; notifying building occupants of fire or fire department operations; directing evacuations; testing building fire systems, including automatic sprinklers, standpipes, and elevator control; maintaining fire prevention plan; supervising and training fire brigades, floor wardens, and building evacuation supervisors; performing fire inspections; conducting, supervising, and evaluating fire drills.

Experience: minimum 21 years of age; 5 years of applicable experience in fire protection, fire prevention, or building service equipment.

Qualifications: Current State Security Officer license/registration; current Certificate of Fitness as a Fire Safety Director.

Training: Training includes State-certified initial, in-service, and refresher training required of Uniformed Security Officer I-Unarmed; previous fire prevention or building service equipment training.

Education: Requires a minimum of High School Diploma.

Police Officer I (SCA code 27131)

Responsibilities: Enforces regulations designed to prevent breaches of security. Exercises judgment and use discretion in dealing with whether first response should be to intervene directly (asking for assistance when deemed necessary and time allows), to keep situation under surveillance, or to report situation so that it can be handled by appropriate authority. Duties require specialized training in methods and techniques of protecting security areas. Commonly, the guard is required to demonstrate continuing physical fitness and proficiency with firearms or other special weapons.

Experience: 21 years of age; one (3) years minimum experience as a law enforcement officer

Education: High school diploma or GED in addition to completion of a certified security training program or local state or federal law enforcement training academy, and successful completion of a certified weapons proficiency course.

Aviation Security Officer (SCA code 27101)

Responsibilities: Protects people, property and/or assets at aviation sites by performing a combination of duties. Range of duties can include but not limited to access control, aircraft security (including hand-wanding), full-security cabin search, ramp and perimeter security, vehicle escorts, fire safety/fire guard, CCTV security monitoring, Customs/black box security, cargo security, traffic management, baggage induction, Security Command Center operations, electronic/CCTV surveillance, concierge services, wheelchair escorts, cargo X-Ray inspections, explosives trace detection, ramp and cargo hold security, CTX baggage screening, undercover investigation, Lost & Found services, high-value escorts, catering security, construction escorts, and Passport and Visa checks, selectee checks, and no-fly list checks.

Experience: 21 years of age; 3 years of Security Experience; Completion of Summit University/Learning Center training.

Qualifications: Security Identification Display Area (SIDA) badge certified. State Security Officer licensed. U.S. Customs clearance. Fireguard certification. Security Officers have passed the rigorous, internal 15-step employment process, which includes candidate recruiting, citizenship/legal alien check utilizing the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's E-Verify program, State-issued security guard license check, Social Security Number verification, proof of High School Diploma or GED, pre-employment interviews, literacy and comprehension tests, passing of a Reid Psychological Test, National and State criminal checks, employment history check, personal reference verification, Department of Motor Vehicles driving record check, passing of a 5-panel drug test, customer-specific screening criteria, and a 90-day probation and training period. Advanced communications skills.

Training: All training is conducted as per federal (FAA/TSA), state, and local (airport) regulations and standards, and performed by qualified/certified management and supervisory personnel. All Security Officers receive at least 16 hours of in-service, hands-on training in the specific disciplines and tasks for which they are accountable. In addition, this training is augmented by daily in-service training from first-line supervisors and security managers on post orders, hot topics, and customer service. Supplemental training includes internet-based video training modules on Suspicious Packages; Response to Active Shooter Incidents; and Enhanced Terrorism Awareness & Response. A Certified Airport Driver Trainer course, a 7-hour course, is provided for Security Officers that operate motor vehicles on site. In addition, all Security Officers receive required State training and additional on-the-job training from Summit supervisors. Training by a State-certified Instructor may include:

All Security Officers will receive in-service training relevant to the security needs of the site, as well as

additional annual or biannual refresher training.

Education: Requires a minimum of High School Diploma.

Supervisor

Responsibilities: Provides leadership and supervisory presence to the security personnel throughout the site. Manages and evaluates the performance of Shift Supervisors. Ensures enactment of cohesive performance management policies and procedures across each shift. Conducts Shift Supervisor briefings as needed. Schedules security personnel to cover designated facilities and shifts, ensuring appropriate staffing levels. Reports to Project Manager; interact directly with Client, as needed. Maintains emergency response plans. Reviews subordinate reports and provides follow-up when needed; provides written and oral reports to Management. Responds to alarms and dispatched calls, taking action as necessary, including notification of appropriate authorities.

Experience: Minimum 3 years of demonstrated security services excellence; former supervisory experience and/or law enforcement/military service preferred.

Qualifications: Current State Security Officer license/registration; demonstrated line security excellence.

Training: Site Supervisors are trained by Project Managers in client facilities and the standard operating procedures for each post, as well as in specific supervisory responsibilities and client requirement. Ongoing reinforcement in leadership principles and practices is part of standard training.

Education: Requires a minimum of High School Diploma.

Shift Supervisor

Responsibilities: Provides leadership and supervisory presence to the security personnel during shift assignment. Manages and evaluates the performance of Security Officers. Ensures enactment of cohesive performance management policies and procedures across designated shift. Conducts Security Officer briefings as needed. Schedules security personnel to cover designated posts, ensuring appropriate staffing levels. Reports to Site Supervisor; interacts directly with Client, as needed. Maintains emergency response plans. Reviews subordinate reports and provides follow-up when needed; provides written and oral reports to Management. Responds to alarms and dispatched calls, taking action as necessary, including notification of appropriate authorities.

Experience: Minimum 2 years of demonstrated security services excellence.

Qualifications: Current State Security Officer license/registration; demonstrated line security excellence.

Training: Shift Supervisors are trained by Site Supervisors/Project Managers in client facilities and the standard operating procedures for each post, as well as in specific supervisory responsibilities and client requirement.
