SERVICES

27101 GUARD I

Functions: Guard I carries out detailed instructions and procedures primarily oriented to insure that emergencies and security violations are readily discovered, and reported to the appropriate authority. The primary duty is to observe and report security and emergency situations. Guard I intervenes only in situations which require minimal action to safeguard property or persons. Duties require that individuals in the Guard I position meet minimal training and physical fitness standards.

Minimum Training: Level I and Level II

Experience: 1-2 Years

27101 GUARD II

Functions: The Guard II enforces regulations and procedures designed to prevent breaches of security, exercises judgment and uses discretion in responding to incidents and emergencies, determining whether to intervene directly, ask for assistance as time permits, keep situation under control or surveillance, or to report incident or situation to the appropriate authority for handling. Duties require specialized training in methods and techniques of protecting controlled areas. Commonly, the Guard II is required to demonstrate proficiency with firearms and other special weapons, and to meet rigorous physical standards.

Minimum Training: Level, Level II, and Level III

Experience: 2 or more years with Level III training



27131 POLICE OFFICER I

Functions: This officer carries out general and specific assignments from superior officers in accordance with established rules procedures, maintains order, enforces laws and ordinances, and protects life and property in assigned patrol district or beat by performing a combination of duties. These duties could include; patrolling a specific area on foot or in a vehicle, directing traffic, issuing traffic summonses, investigating accidents, apprehending and arresting suspects, processing prisoners, and protecting scenes of major crimes. This officer may participate with detectives or investigators in conducting surveillance operations.

Minimum Training: Level I, Level II and Level III

Experience: 3 or more years with military, police officer, special operations, and level III training.

271321 POLICE OFFICER II

Functions: In addition to the basic police duties described at level I, the Police Officer II receives additional compensation to specialize in one or more activities, such as canine patrol, special reaction teams, juvenile cases, hostage negotiations, and participating in investigations or other enforcement activities requiring specialized training and skills.

Minimum Training: Level I, Level II and Level III

Experience: 4 or more years with military, police officer, special operations, and level III training. Supervisory experience a plus.
