Should the contractor not be able to meet all requirement(s) in the statement of work, the contractor's quote must specifically identify the items which have not been included in the quoted price. Contractors may serve as a Prime contractor and subcontract the installation or site preparation services unless specifically prohibited by the ordering contracting officer. Subcontractors must comply with any licensing and bonding requirements specified in the statement of work. The contractor shall ensure all warranties are honored. All construction work must be guaranteed for any defect in workmanship and materials.
