TRAINING COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

Weapons of Mass Destruction – Basic Training

Course Description:

This course will teach students basic WMD awareness. Students will learn what Weapons of Mass Destruction are and how Weapons of Mass Destruction can affect them. What do they look and smell like and their possible dispersal methods. Students would receive a history of chemical and biological warfare and terrorism and get a firm understanding of the differences between Biological, Chemical, and Radiological Weapons and their affects on the human body. In addition they will learn to protect themselves and others and provide basic decontamination. Students will learn about personal protection equipment like “escape masks” and how to properly don masks. The students will also learn how to prepare and operate in an emergency shelter.

Course Length: 8 hours

Weapons of Mass Destruction – Advanced Training

Course Description:

This course will teach students Advanced WMD awareness. Students will learn what Weapons of Mass Destruction are and how Weapons of Mass Destruction can affect them. What do they look and smell like and their possible dispersal methods. Students would receive a history of chemical and biological warfare and terrorism and get a firm understanding of the differences between Biological, Chemical, and Radiological Weapons and their affects on the human body, how to decon and secure the location. In addition they will learn to protect themselves and others and provide advanced decontamination methodologies. Students will learn about personal protection equipment like “escape masks” and how to properly don masks. The students will also learn how to prepare and operate in an emergency shelter. How to decontaminate in an emergency situation.
