To ensure the best quality service to our clients, Bay Ridge Security uses several capabilities of our company to bring together a proven and effective system to ensure client satisfaction.



----- **Description of Guard Services** -----

Guard I: Unarmed, Uniformed Officer

Responsibilities: Carries out instructions primarily oriented toward ensuring that emergencies and security violations are readily discovered and reported to appropriate authority. Intervenes directly only in situations which require minimal action to safeguard property or persons. Must be dependable, reliable and possess sound judgment. Must have good interpersonal skills and present a neat and professional appearance. Duties also include: communicating with and providing assistance to the public, plus assistance with reports and duty logs; maintaining security at the client's facility by properly working assigned post; conducting roving patrols; working with minimal supervision; preparing complete duty logs, incident reports and other reports as required; working on both stationary and roving posts; and rendering security assistance as needed.

Training/Education Required: High school diploma or GED. Must successfully complete a background investigation to include a criminal, credit, reference checks and drug screening.

Years and Type of Experience Required: 18 years of age; 1 year of continuous work experience that demonstrates reliability, dependability, attention to detail and a good work ethic.

Guard I: Armed Uniformed Officer

Functional Responsibilities: Must demonstrate knowledge of the legal authority and limitations of an armed security officer. Must be of sound character and present a neat and professional appearance. Duties also include: securing and safeguarding the personnel, guests, visitors and property of the client; conducting stationary and roving patrols; communicating with and providing assistance to the public; preparing reports and duty logs; and rendering assistance as necessary.

Training/Education Required: High school diploma or GED plus completion of a certified security training program or local, state or federal law enforcement training academy. Successfully complete a firearms re-qualification program annually. Must pass a background investigation that includes criminal, credit and reference checks and drug screening.

Years and Type of Experience required: 21 years of age; 3 years of continuous work experience with 1-year experience in security or law enforcement.

Guard II: Unarmed Uniformed Officer

Responsibilities: Enforces regulations to prevent breaches of security. Exercises judgment and uses discretion in dealing with first responder issues. Keeps situations under surveillance, and reports situations to the proper authorities. Duties also include: communicating with and providing assistance to the public; standing post; performing duties as assigned; maintaining order and discipline at assigned post; preparing complete duty logs, incident reports and other reports as required; working on both stationary and roving posts; and rendering security assistance as needed.

Training/Education Required: High school diploma or GED. Must successfully complete a background investigation to include a criminal, credit, reference checks and drug screening.

Years and Type of Experience Required: 21 years of age; be a citizen of the United States of America; 3 years of continuous work experience that demonstrates reliability, dependability, attention to detail and a good work ethic.

Guard II: Armed Uniformed Officer

Responsibilities: Must demonstrate knowledge of the legal authority and limitations of an armed security officer. Exercises judgment and uses discretion in dealing with first responder issues, keeps situations under surveillance, and reports situations to the proper authorities. Must be of sound character and present a neat and professional appearance. Duties also include: securing and safeguarding the personnel, guests, visitors and property of the client; conducting stationary and roving patrols; communicating with and providing assistance to the public; preparing reports and duty logs; and rendering assistance as necessary.

Guard II: Armed Uniformed Officer **continued**

Training/Education Required: High school diploma or GED plus completion of a certified security-training program or local state or federal law enforcement-training academy. Successfully complete a firearms re-qualification program annually. Must pass a background investigation that includes criminal, credit and reference checks and drug screening.

Years and Type of Experience Required: 21 years of age; 3 years of continuous work experience with 2 years experience in security or law enforcement; be a citizen of the United States of America.

Court Security Officer: Armed or Unarmed Uniformed Officer

Training/Education Required: High school diploma or GED plus completion of a certified security-training program or local state or federal law enforcement-training academy. Successfully complete a firearms re-qualification program annually. Must pass a background investigation that includes criminal, credit and reference checks and drug screening.

Years and Type of Experience Required: 21 years of age; 3 years of continuous work experience with 2 years experience in security or law enforcement; be a citizen of the United States of America.

Functional Responsibilities:

1. Patrols courthouse to provide security.
2. Escorts defendants to and from courtroom.
3. Stand guard during court proceedings.
4. Check courtroom for security.
5. Monitoring of court entrances.
6. Attend to special needs of the court system particularly in the area of personal protection for the judges, jurors, witnesses, attorneys and other persons involved with the court to include the general public.
