The following project descriptions illustrate MCE's ability to complete a wide range of environmental projects.

Transportation and Disposal – New Rochelle, NY

MCE is responsible for disposal of waste materials from the demolition of a former military base. Waste materials include, PCB contaminated concrete and soil, lead debris, asbestos wastes, and non-hazardous debris. All wastes are moved in 30-yard roll-off containers. The location of the project, an island, presents logistical challenges in the transportation of materials. All roll-off cans and waste materials are transported to and from the island via barge. To date, more than 300 roll-off cans have been transported off the island. Schedules must be carefully coordinated to ensure efficient loading and unloading of barges to keep the project running smoothly.

Remediation/ Site Restoration – Wallops Island, VA

The property was being renovated into additional staging/parking area. The site in question had been used primarily for the storage of scrap metal, empty drums, transformers, and used batteries. Mill City Environmental (MCE) was contracted to perform excavation both conventional & vacuum of 3,000 tons of contaminated soil. MCE also performed site restoration tasks of backfilling, compaction and the producing of final grades for the parking/staging area. MCE worked along with the site engineer to provide waste characterization and confirmatory sampling support. MCE provided all the pre-approval paper work, shipping documents and tracking of all the waste streams.



Waste Disposal Services – Albany, NY

MCE entered into a multi-year contract to dispose of wastes from VA Medical Center. Wastes include hazardous, non-hazardous, and biological materials. MCE is responsible for characterizing, profiling, transportation, and disposal of all materials. MCE also offers additional compliance support to the Medical Center on an as needed basis.

Tank Removal – Lowell, MA

Mill City Environmental Corporation (MCE) was responsible for pumping, cleaning, and removing 4 underground storage tanks. These tanks were discovered during excavation activities while the site was under construction. MCE responded to an emergency call to remove the tanks so construction could proceed.
