### **What is MOBIS?**

The MOBIS Federal Supply Schedule is offered to federal agencies by the GSA to provide them with a streamlined procurement device to procure management consulting, facilitation, survey and quality-related training services.

Key advantages of the MOBIS contract are:

- FEDBIZOPPS(FBO) synopsis is NOT required.
- Competition requirements have been met (FAR 6.102 (d)(3))
- Direct client/contractor relationship.
- All applicable laws and regulations have been applied (including small business set-aside determination, FAR 19.502-1).
- Prices have been determined by the Government to be fair and reasonable.

## Authorized Federal Government Users

The agencies listed below can utilize the MOBIS contracting vehicle:

- All federal agencies and activities in the Executive, Legislative, and Judicial branches.
- Government contractors authorized in writing by a federal agency pursuant to CFR 51.1.
- Mixed ownership government corporations (as defined in Government Corporation Control Act).
- The government of the District of Columbia.
- Other activities and organizations authorized by statute or regulation to use GSA source of supply.

Placing orders under the MOBIS schedule is simple, cost-effective, and efficient. Briefly, to ensure that the “Best Value” determination is made, as required by FAR 8.404, clients wishing to utilize the MOBIS contracting vehicle need to:

- Consider price, special qualifications, administrative costs, etc., and
- Place order(s) directly with contractor.

**Minimum education:** Masters and 10 years relevant work experience or PhD and 5 years experience.

**Consultant Senior-** Provides expert service and leadership on-site with client organization using a variety of consulting skills, including analytical process assessment and development planning facilitation, performance measurement training, project management and process and productivity analysis. Provides expert advice and assistance in state-of-the-art hardware and software. Coordinates with program/task management and customer personnel to ensure the requirements have been properly defined and the solution will be satisfactory. May lead the consulting team and act as Project Manager giving directions on management consulting projects.

**Minimum education:** Bachelor's and 5 years relevant work experience or Masters and 3 years relevant work experience

**Consultant-** Performs studies and reviews of analysis process structures to evaluate performance relative to organizational objectives. Advises on analysis process strategies and realignment issues to focus on most beneficial objectives. Addresses issues affecting management and business process to improve productivity while re-engineering the development cycle. Provides assistance in the evaluation, auditor service, and implementation support of quality standards to achieve goals. Provides leadership in government and industry meetings, briefings, and forums to facilitate the exchange of ideas and concepts.

The analyst also performs statistical analysis on the available data sets and gives a meaningful report after the analysis is completed. Develops and implements operations test and assessments. Develops and maintains functional and operating documentation.

**Minimum education:** Bachelor's and 5 years relevant work experience

**Data Analyst-** Professional give direction in gathering and organizing information on problem or procedures including present operating procedures Assist junior staff in analyzing data, developing information , and assessing available solutions or alternate methods of proceeding The analyst is responsible for coordinating with clients and trains users to ensure smooth implementation and functional performance of new systems, procedures or surveys. Develops and implements operations test and assessments. Develops and maintains functional and operating documentation.

**Minimum education:** Bachelor's and 3 years relevant work experience

**Data Analyst- (Junior Level)-**Gathers and organizes information on problem or procedures including present operating procedures. Analyzes data, develops information, and assesses available solutions or alternate methods of proceeding. The analyst is responsible for coordinating with clients and trains users to ensure smooth Implementation and functional performance of new systems procedures or surveys. Performs statistical analysis on the available datasets and give a meaningful report after the analysis is completed. Develops and implements operations test and assessments. Develops and maintains functional and operating documentation.

**Minimum education:** Bachelor's and 1 year's relevant work experience

**Business Training Specialist – (Senior).** Conducts the research necessary to develop and revise training courses and prepares appropriate training catalogs. Develops all instructor materials (course outline, background material, and training aids). Develops all student materials (course manuals, workbooks, handouts, completion certificates, and course critique forms). trains personnel by conducting formal classroom courses, workshops, seminars and/or computer based/computer aided training and provides daily supervision and direction to staff.

**Minimum education:** Bachelor's and 3 years relevant work experience

The Service Contract Act (SCA) is applicable to this contract as it applies to the entire MOBIS Schedule and all services provided. While no specific labor categories have been identified as being subject to SCA due to exemptions for professional employees (FAR 22.1101, 22.1102 and 29 CFR 541.300), this contract still maintains the provisions and protections for SCA eligible labor categories. If and/or when the contractor adds SCA labor categories/employees to the contract through the modification process, the contractor must inform the Contracting Officer and establish a SCA matrix identifying the GSA labor category titles, the occupational code, SCA labor category titles and the applicable wage determination number. Failure to do so may result in cancellation of the contract.
