In this capacity the subject matter expert will provide specialized planning, analysis, modeling, and implementation support for executive information and decision support systems, fraud prevention modeling, data mining, data warehousing, and enterprise-wide decision making architectures. The subject matter expert will employ integrated methodologies and technologies appropriate to each task, including executive/program decision-making.
