Services Available to Ordering Agencies through HVF West

Services available as part of GSA/FSS Contract GS-10F-0088U include:

1. **Processing** and reduction of materials (ranging in size from Micro-processors to Jumbo-jets) to pre-determined sizes (and as negotiated at task order level) through torch cutting, shearing and shredding with proprietary procedures and equipment.
2. **Sortation** of materials to predetermined standards of purity and material likeness; level of sortation to be predetermined at task order level.
3. **Demilitarization** including reduction and/or mutilation of items to a state of complete destruction and/or in accordance with DoD 4160.21-M-1 regulations preventing reassembly, future use for original purpose, or reverse engineering for duplication.
4. **Development and management** of sustainable material recovery programs; through closed-loop recycling alternatives facilities may retain ownership of Class "S" materials for enhanced recovery value.
5. **Material Disposition:** With two options available to Ordering Agencies, maximum value can be recovered from processed items; recovered materials can either be:
 - a. **Returned to the Government Customer:** for resale and/or disposition at the Government's discretion.
 - b. **Purchased by HVF West LLC:** Fair Market Value (FMV) based on indices and markets determined at the task order level.

Labor: Duties and Requirements

Project Manager

Requirements: This position requires US Citizenship. If performed by personnel outside of key HVF Management, this position requires college degree and/or management certification; a combination of verified government contracting experience and management coursework equivalent to ten years experience will also satisfy the educational requirements.

Duties: Examines government customer requirements and translates these requirements into operational plans with reporting directly to HVF West Officers. Project Manager plans, directs and coordinates (on and off-site) project operations. Analyzes current and future project needs. Assists in development of performance based Statements of Work (SOW's) and assists in translation of SOW's into procedural plans to be implemented. Project Manager is also responsible for monitoring and reporting of costs, budgets, schedules, contract modifications, change-orders, and staffing requirements.

Site Safety Consultant

Requirements: Requires US Citizenship and completion of DoD Certification courses for demilitarization operations. A college degree and/or management certification is preferred; however, a combination of education and/or 5 years experience in government operations can be substituted for college education.

Duties: Provides oversight of material demilitarization, certification of weights and measurements. Site safety consultant performs duties on and off site and requires implementing work directives without direct oversight of project managers. The site safety consultant carries out directives issued by HVF West Management and Officers in accordance with standard operating procedures, policies and processes as they pertain to security of materials and environment. When required, position requires coordination with government customer, HVF West Management and Project Manager(s) for demilitarization certification when required by government customer.

Operator

Requirements: US Citizenship required. High school or G.E.D. is preferred however; experience in general heavy equipment operations work which includes experience in dismantling and/or demolition with verified references (where available), and demonstrated abilities are considered. Operator must be licensed in the operation of equipment being used when and where required. Operator must possess a thorough knowledge of heavy industrial equipment including use of specialized attachments with hydraulic shearing and demolition capabilities. Operator must possess knowledge, abilities, and skills necessary to perform essential functions in the operation and maintenance of equipment including feeding conveyors and observation of all applicable occupational safety precautions.

Duties: Operation of equipment ranging from light industrial construction equipment to large track-hoe type excavators equipped with hydraulic shearing and demolition capabilities

Site Laborer

Requirements: US Citizenship required. Position requires a thorough working knowledge of the maintenance and operation of Fritz™ Hammermill shredding equipment in the 500-2000 HP Class with Eddy Current Separation™ Technology. Laborers also must possess a working knowledge in the readiness and preparation of (military and other) materials and equipment for processing. High school or G.E.D. is preferred however; experience in material recovery operations can be substituted for education.

Duties: Laborers are skilled in the use of multiple hand tools and operate small equipment when required for duties required on projects. Such skills include, but are not limited to; installation, maintenance and repair of 32 – 46 Inch hydraulic shearing equipment as well as identification, separation, and accounting of materials based on types, sizes and condition. Laborers are required to possess intuitive skills necessary for identification of tasks with minimal oversight and intervention.
