The Government will require repair or replacement of nonconforming supplies or reperformance of nonconforming services at no increase in contract price. The Government will exercise its post acceptance rights (1) within a reasonable time after the defect was discovered or should have been discovered; and (2) before any substantial change occurs in the condition of the item, unless the change is due to the defect in the item.

- (ii) **Assignment.** AECOM or its assignee's rights to be paid amounts due as a result of performance of this contract, may be assigned to a bank, trust company, or other financing institution, including any Federal lending agency in accordance with the Assignment of Claims Act (31 U.S.C. 3727).
  
- (iii) **Disputes.** This contract is subject to the Contract Disputes Act of 1978, as amended (41 U.S.C. 601-613). Failure of the parties to this contract to reach agreement on any request for equitable adjustment, claim, appeal or action arising under or relating to this contract shall be a dispute to be resolved in accordance with the clause at FAR 52.233-1, Disputes, which is incorporated herein by reference. AECOM will proceed diligently with performance arising under the contract.
  
- (iv) **Definitions.** FAR 52.202-1, Definitions, is incorporated in the Addendum to this clause.
  
- (v) **Excusable Delays.** AECOM will be liable for default unless nonperformance is caused by an occurrence beyond AECOM's reasonable control and without its fault or negligence such as acts of God or the public enemy, acts of the Government in either its sovereign or contractual capacity, fires, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, unusually severe weather, and delays of common carriers. AECOM will notify the Contracting Officer in writing as soon as it is reasonably possible after the commencement of any excusable delay, setting forth the full particulars in connection therewith, shall remedy such occurrence with all reasonable dispatch, and shall promptly give written notice to the Contracting Officer of the cessation of such occurrence. AECOM will also notify the Contracting Officer of the ordering activity agency in writing as set forth above when service is expected to be delayed.
  
- (vi) **Invoice Requirements.** The number of invoices required is an original and three copies (or electronic invoice, if authorized) to the address designated in the contract to receive invoices. An invoice must include:
  - a. Name and address of the Contractor;
  - b. Invoice date;
  - c. Contract number, contract line item number and, if applicable, the order number;
  - d. Description, quantity, unit of measure, unit price and extended price of the item delivered;
  - e. Shipping number and date of shipment including the bill of lading number and weight of shipment if shipped on Government bill of lading;
  - f. Terms of any prompt payment discount offered;
  - g. Name and address of official to whom payment is to be sent; and,

h. Name, title, and phone number of person to be notified in event of defective invoice.

Invoices must be handled in accordance with the Prompt Payment Act (31 U.S.C. 3903) and Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Circular A-125, Prompt Payment.

- (vii) **Patent Indemnity.** AECOM will indemnify the Government and its officers, employees and agents against liability, including costs, for actual or alleged direct or contributory infringement of, or inducement to infringe, any United States or foreign patent, trademark or copyright, arising out of the performance of this contract, provided AECOM is reasonably notified of such claims and proceedings.

AECOM offers comprehensive support services to agencies by providing project management, consultation and deliverables. Expertise include, but are not limited to, the translation of business, legal, medical and technical documents, manuals, web sites, multimedia, intranet, video, audio, and software localization.

## **SINS 382-2 & 382-2RC Interpretation Services**

AECOM provides support services to agencies by providing oral multilingual interpretation (simultaneous and/or consecutive) services for meetings, conferences, seminars, litigation proceedings, briefings, training, escort and other forms of voice communication requirements from a source language in the target language. Sign language is included.

AECOM offers professional and experienced interpreters that possess demonstrated proficiency levels that range from the ability to speak the language with sufficient structural accuracy and vocabulary, to participate effectively in most formal and informal conversations on practical, social and professional topics.

Simultaneous interpretation is typically performed in formal situations with the interpreter in a closed booth outfitted with sound equipment. Interpretation is performed while the source language speaker speaks. During simultaneous interpretation, the interpreter does not seek clarification from the speaker and the interpretation does not affect the pace of the discussion.

Consecutive interpretation is typically performed in informal situations with the interpreter in close proximity to the source language speaker. During the speech, the interpreter may take notes and the interpretation in the target language is provided after the source language speaker has finished speaking.

In escort interpretation, the individual or delegation is accompanied by an interpreter on a visit or on a tour. Interpretation is provided in the consecutive mode.
