

<b>Minimum Education:</b> Master's degree in a technical, business, or management area. Bachelor's degree with an additional 5 years of applicable experience may be substituted for the degree requirement.

The Service Contract Act (SCA) is applicable to this contract as it applies to the entire Professional Engineering Services (PES) Schedule and all services provided.
