Agriculture Analyst

Has training in an agricultural* science, agricultural economics or other social science with specific emphasis on agriculturally-led economic development in developing countries. Experienced in analyzing the development, diffusion and adoption of new agricultural technology, the integration of producers and rural enterprises into local, regional and global markets, and/or the sustainable management of natural resources, particularly in the context of development programs and projects. Is knowledgeable of policy and governance issues and gender implications of agriculture programs and projects.

Education: Bachelor's Degree.

Experience: Has five (5) years or more of experience in most or all of these elements.

*Agriculture is defined as "the science and practice of activity related to food, feed, and fiber production, processing, marketing, distribution, utilization, and trade, and also includes family and consumer sciences, nutrition, food science and engineering, agricultural economics and other social sciences, forestry, wildlife, fisheries, aquaculture, floraculture, veterinary medicine, and other environmental and natural resources sciences."

Function: Assess the economic performance of companies and industries. Analyze financial data, spot trends, and develop forecasts. Write reports and make presentations. Use the data to measure the financial risks associated with making a particular investment decision.

Social Scientist (includes Economist)
