Creative Recycling Systems, Inc is a licensed secondary metals and electronics recycler offering full-service solutions for end-of-life technology and electronic product asset management needs.

Creative Recycling Systems is headquartered in Tampa, Florida, and was incorporated on January 6, 1994. Its electronic recycling operations are based in Tampa and Tallahassee Florida, Medley Florida, and Palmetto Georgia. These facilities incorporate an operating capacity in excess of 125,000 square feet to process a wide range of electronic equipment from transistors to centrifuges.

Creative Recycling Systems customer base is all-encompassing and comprised of over 1000 companies nationwide and a client list that includes multiple Fortune 100 companies; CRS's long term industry involvement has led to important enhancement of many well-known and respected nonprofit agencies and causes; these efforts most recently include the donation of laptop computers to the Red Cross to aid their efforts in the wake of Hurricane's Katrina and Rita.

### **Data Security**

CRS provides asset management including the tracking, data security, destruction, and certification of destroyed sensitive equipment and products (see Capabilities); their expertise has been especially important in the design, implementation, and management of significant regional recycling programs for local, state, and federal agencies.

### **Value Added**

CRS adds value for its customers in several ways. In cases involving the identification of equipment with potential resale value, CRS utilizes its expertise to maximize the resulting revenue. After exhaustive research and due diligence, CRS utilizes known safe end-markets to recycle these materials. CRS utilizes environmentally sound methodologies to manage end-of-life electronics and equipment. Through the de-manufacturing or disassembly of end-of-life electronic equipment, CRS extracts potentially hazardous materials such as printed circuit boards, cathode ray tubes, and batteries, and documents their appropriate recycling, thereby protecting the customer from future liabilities.

### Diverse Capabilities

CRS processes surplus computers, non-ferrous metals (copper and aluminum), ferrous (steel) metals, precious metals, and electronics. Examples of our standard processing capacity include computers, mainframes, hubs, routers, switches and other telecommunication items to the secure handling of such diverse items as electronic components of military based electronics and tracking systems used in watercraft and warplanes.

### Federal Programs

Creative recycling has developed and provided turnkey recycling services including logistics development, disposition of waste products and monitoring for the EPA in its Region 4 offices, recycling of approximately 30,000 postal scales and point-of-sale systems originating from the US Postal Service and under CRS developed guidelines.

CRS has recycled millions of pounds of electronics and metals under programs developed and or integrated with various military facilities within the DRMO and GSA organizations including; Eglin AFB, Homestead AFB, Mayfield AFB, MacDill AFB, Patrick AFB and the Naval Air Station Jacksonville, and other Federal Agencies such as VA Hospitals, US District Court, US Federal Court and the US Marshals Office, and others.





## SIN 899-5 Labor Descriptions



### **Principal Consultant**

**Duties:** The Principal Consultant provides a high degree of expertise on an as-needed basis and is responsible for solution design, development, deployment, and overall high-level promotion of environmental systems ultimately comprised of policies, procedures, and processes under close scrutiny of public oversight. The Principal Consultant is responsible for coordination of duties with personnel involved in the development of solutions. The Principal Consultant is the go-to person with regards to all communications with Government personnel and is ultimately responsible for contract completion and adherence to Creative Recycling Systems standards of excellence.

**Requirements:** This position is performed exclusively by CRS principals experienced in all phases of environmental system management. Candidate must be US Citizen and requires the experience of a Principal Consultant including a level of expertise that can only be gained through administering an award winning recycling services firm.

### **Senior Consultant**

**Duties:** The Senior Consultant provides leadership services in diverse environmental management areas as well as expertise in directing the Project/Program managers in systems/solutions development situations. Senior Consultant is authorized to direct personnel without oversight and is often to be tasked with the responsibility of overall project management after an initial consultation has been completed and a work order is issued. The Senior Consultant is the recognized go-to person for all CRS personnel and reports directly to the Principals of the company.

**Requirements:** This position requires US Citizenship. If performed by personnel other than those in the direct CRS labor pool, position requires minimum of a Bachelors Degree in a business discipline as well as a minimum of four years experience in specialized solutions dealing with environmental systems technology and/or government contracting. Certain amounts of governmental contracting experience may be substituted if performed within the CRS labor pool.

### **Program Manager**

**Duties:** Plans, directs and coordinates new business, supports and participates in negotiations with customers. Analyzes current situation and develops business plans and strategy. Determines customer requirements and translates these requirements into operational plans, program manager monitors and reviews costs, operational budgets, schedules, and staffing requirements for project team. Analyzes effects of project upon various operating and support areas to determine the most practical and cost effective method to obtain the required resources. Program manager also provides guidance to project team and management in directing development of new applications and formulating contingency plans in areas such as schedule revisions, personnel adjustments, fund allocations, and work requirements.

**Requirements:** Requires Bachelors degree if performed using contract labor outside the direct CRS labor pool. Candidate must be US Citizen with degree related technical discipline. Position requires 5 years industry experience in multiple phases and all aspects of project management. Also qualifying is a Master's Degree and two (2) years of experience.

### **Project Manager**

**Duties:** Plans, directs and coordinates the business operations at an operational account stage as well as directly supporting Program Manager in issue resolution. Analyzes current/proposed project situation and develops plans, strategy and acceptance of new business procedures. Determines customer requirements and translates these requirements into operational plans with reporting to Program Manager. Project Manager is also provides guidance to project team and is responsible for the monitoring and review of costs, budgets, schedules, and staffing requirements. Project Manager typically reports to Program Manager and/or CRS Principals. Project Manager is also directly responsible for formulating strategy and contingency plans in such issues as schedule revisions, manpower adjustments, fund allocations, and work requirements. As such needs become apparent the Project Manager is also often responsible for preparing incoming management in the transition from implementation to business operating stage.

**Requirements:** Requires Bachelors degree if performed using contract labor outside the direct CRS labor pool. Candidate must be a US Citizen with formal education in Business Administration/Sciences and/or other related technical discipline. Position requires a minimum of five (5) years experience in all phases and aspects of project management. Also qualifying is a Master's (or other advanced) Degree and three (3) years of hands-on management experience

### **Contract Manager**

**Duties:** Plans and directs contract delivery for customer. Plans and oversees the delivery of contracted services according to terms and tends to customer satisfaction with services. Maintains business relationships between customer and CRS management team, as well as manages and coordinates resources responsible productivity and contract evolution.

Primary responsibility also includes delivery of value to the customer while advising the customer on CRS strategy including integration, team selection and operations while representing CRS with authority to deliver on commitments.

**Requirements:** Requires Bachelors degree if performed using contract labor outside the direct CRS labor pool. Candidate must be a US Citizen with demonstrated success in developing and contracted sales solutions. Successful candidates must at least 7 years experience, with at least 80% of said time occurring in a government contracting capacity

Successful candidate must have the ability to manage project changes and the ability to evaluate and provide advice on business process issues. Five years of experience at a consulting level within County, State, and/or Federal Government sectors will substitute for degree requirements. Five to seven years of deep experience and exposure to an environment which with a wide understanding business contracting processes will substitute for degree requirements.
