## MOBIS Labor Category Descriptions

### Senior Partner

This position requires a minimum of fifteen years experience in a key field of consulting required by the contract, including business consulting, procurement or law. Overall manager and administrator for department wide strategic studies. Primary interface and point of contact with Senior Government program authorities and representatives on critical issues. Primary contributor to project, responsible for content and project quality and content. Manages and controls financial and administrative aspects of the program with respect to contract requirements. A Ph.D. in Computer Science, Mathematics, Engineering, Statistics or Business Administration, or Law Degree from an accredited college or university, or other advanced degree.

### Partner

This position requires a minimum of five years experience in a key field of consulting required by the contract, including business consulting, procurement or law, or other advanced degree. Overall manager and administrator of studies or projects. Serves as the primary interface and point of contact with Government program authorities and representatives on program and content issues. Supervises program operations by implementing procedures for planning and directing the execution of the studies. Primary contributor to studies and projects. Manages acquisition and employment of program/project resources. Manages and controls financial and administrative aspects of the program/project with respect to contract requirements. May be supervised by a Senior Partner. A Ph.D. in Computer Science, Mathematics, Engineering, Statistics or Business Administration from an accredited college or A Master's Degree and ten years of experience.

### Technical Director

Specialized experience includes: Five years experience in management consulting or ten years in a technical field directly related to the contract. Technical contributor for a particular task or project effort. Serves as the primary technical interface and point of contact with Government program authorities and representatives on specific technical issues. A Master's degree in a technical field of interest to the contract or project in Information Systems, Engineering, Business, or other related scientific or technical discipline. A Bachelors degree and fifteen years of general experience is required.

### Principal Consultant

Minimum of five years of experience in management consulting or a field related to the contract. Manages tasks within large studies. Contributor to primary research and analysis. Analyzes and studies complex system requirements. A Bachelor's Degree in Mathematics, Engineering, Statistics or Business Administration from an accredited college or university.

### Program Manager

This position requires a minimum of eight years experience. Experience includes increasing responsibilities in program design and management. Serves as interface and point of contact with Government program authorities and representatives on delivery/task order issues. Supervises operations by developing procedures, planning and directing execution of the technical, programming, maintenance and administrative support effort and monitoring and reporting progress. Manages acquisition and employment of resources. Manages and controls financial and administrative aspects with respect to delivery/task order requirements. A Bachelor's Degree from an accredited college or university.

### Senior Consultant

Experience as management consultant, knowledge of quantitative and decision support analysis techniques. Demonstrated ability to work under general direction. This position requires a minimum of five years experience. Analyzes functional business applications and design specifications for functional activities. Develops block diagrams and logic flow charts. Translates detailed design into computer software. Tests, debugs, and refines the computer software to produce the required product. Prepares required documentation, including both program-level and user-level documentation. Enhances software to reduce operating time or improve efficiency. Provides technical direction to programmers to ensure program deadlines are met. A Bachelor's degree in Computer Science, Information Systems, Engineering, Business, or other related scientific or technical discipline. With seven years of general experience, a degree is not required

**Consultant**

Specialized experience includes experience as an applications programmer on data base management systems, knowledge of computer equipment and ability to develop complex software to satisfy design objectives. Demonstrated ability to work under general direction. This position requires a minimum of four years experience. Performs research and background analyses to be used in project, under the direction of a senior consultant or director. Provides general management consulting support. Prepares required documentation and charts. A Bachelor's degree in Computer Science, Information Systems, Engineering, Business, or other related scientific or technical discipline. With six years of general experience, a degree is not required.

**Project Management Specialist**

Works with limited supervision and direction. Required to use judgment and initiative in problem solving. This position requires a minimum of two years experience. Knowledge of COTS to include but not limited to MS Office tools: Excel, Word and MS Project. Assists in the preparation of management plans and reports in support of projects. Coordinates schedules to facilitate completion of contract deliverables, task order review, briefings/presentations, and In Process Review (IPR) preparation. Performs analysis, development, and review of program administrative operating procedures. All work performed in support of management consulting projects. Requires a Bachelor's Degree, or an Associate's degree and five years of experience.

**Senior Technical Writer**

Specialized experience includes demonstrated experience in editing documents, including technical documents. Demonstrated ability to work independently or under general direction. This position requires a minimum of three years experience. Develops, drafts, revises, and edits reports, articles, manuals, specifications, presentation materials, and other technical documents, using rough outlines and materials. Interprets information obtained through research and provided by technical specialists. Applies knowledge of documentation content and format standards to prepare, edit, and publish technical materials. A Bachelor's degree in English, Literature, or other related discipline. With five year's general experience, a degree is not required.
