Minimum 14 years experience and Masters. An alternative would be minimum 19 years experience and Bachelors.
Project Manager	Provides overall administrative and technical management, from bid preparation to project completion, on multiple medium size projects of moderate to high complexity. Develops new business opportunities with existing and prospective clients. Minimum 7 years experience and Bachelors.
Senior Hydrogeologist	Acts as internal hydrogeologist consultant for the discipline. Ensures all related investigations, sampling, monitoring, and other activities are performed in accordance with accepted professional and company practices and standards. Minimum 15 years experience and Bachelors.
