Engineer 4	Responsibilities include programmatic or technical lead at the project, task or subtask level for smaller magnitude efforts addressing technically complex issues that span multiple engineering disciplines. Minimum qualifications include Bachelors in engineering plus 15 years relevant experience.
Engineer 3	Responsibilities include programmatic or technical lead at the project, task or subtask level for smaller magnitude efforts that address technical issues focused in one engineering discipline.
