Program Manager III

Requires a master's degree or equivalent and a minimum of 10 years of experience; oversees multidisciplinary staff, monitors project performance, and ensures successful project performance.

Senior Analyst

Requires a master's degree (or equivalent) and a minimum of 6 years of experience; understanding of the application of scientific data to regulation and policy development.

Senior Chemical Engineer

Requires a master's degree or equivalent in chemical engineering and a minimum of 4 years of experience.

Senior Environmental Scientist III

Requires a master's degree (or equivalent) in environmental science, biology, chemistry or a related subject and a minimum of 6 years of experience; knowledge of environmental sciences applications.

Requires a bachelor's degree or equivalent and a minimum of 7 years of experience; understands regulatory development and public input processes.

GIS Specialist

Requires a bachelor's degree or equivalent and four years of experience working with related software programs to create and maintain data/maps that can be combined with geographically referenced data. Responsible for data management, mapping, training, and analysis for resource assessments, geospatial analysis, scientific investigations, planning, or modeling.

Environmental Scientist II
