Labor Category Descriptions

Project Manager: The role of the Project Manager (PM) is budget management, logical coordination of staff, resources, all staff and field activities and writing of field/lab reports. The role of the Project Manager (PM) also involves undertaking and delegating field activities, various analyses and cataloguing as needed.

Requires a M.A. in Anthropology/ Archaeology and at least 1 year project management experience.

Principal Investigator: The role of the Principal Investigator (PI) is to serve as lead on projects, including the coordination with the client throughout the project, setting up field and laboratory procedures, writing of all reports and coordination with regulatory authorities.

Requires a M.A. in Anthropology/ Archaeology and 5 years working in CRM.

Forensic Anthropologist: The role of the Forensic Anthropologist is to undertake all laboratory analysis related to human and faunal remains, creation of artifact databases and input to writing specific sections of field reports.

Requires M.A. in Anthropology/ Archaeology and 5 years working in the field of physical anthropology.

Conservationist: The role of the Conservationist is to undertake all laboratory work related to the conservation of specific artifacts.

Requires M.A. in Anthropology/ Archaeology or M.S. in scientific field and 5 years experience working in the field of conservation.

Business Development/ Program Manager: The role of the Business Development/Program Manager is to make initial contacts with potential new clients, develop and modify the company's business plan and garner new contracts. In addition, they serve as the primary contact with the client to oversee all phases of the project to ensure the clients' expectations are met.
