### **Introduction to Cascade**

Cascade History - Cascade was formed in 1999 to provide comprehensive information technology equipment retirement services for businesses, institutions and government agencies. Cascade has a history of providing quality and competitive services to the federal government, as evidenced by our national agreement with the FDIC since 2003. The company now operates full scale processing facilities in Wisconsin and Indiana and collects between 200 - 250 tons of computers, office electronics, consumer electronics and test equipment each month from sites across the United States.

Corporate Headquarters & Processing Facility - Cascade's headquarters is in Madison, Wisconsin where it occupies a standalone 42,000 square foot facility with just over 25,000 square feet dedicated to processing activities (collection, consolidation, inventory, data wiping, media destruction, testing services, demanufacturing for recycling, and shredding.) The original building was constructed in 2005 with a 9,000 square foot addition added in 2007. The facility houses Cascade support and administrative operations, as well. The building meets NAID standards for security.

**Indiana Processing Facility** - Cascade's Indianapolis facility, conveniently situated in the "crossroads of America," includes over 28,000 square feet of production and office space (used for collection, consolidation, inventory, data wiping, media destruction, testing services, demanufacturing for recycling, and shredding.) The building is secure with concrete walls, surveillance within and outside the building, access controls, and motion sensors.

Scope and Capabilities - Each location features hauling and logistics services, asset control and tracking, refurbishing and repair, demanufacturing of equipment for recycling, and secure media destruction through electronic scrubbing of hard drives and physical destruction by shredding and punching of drives. Whatever cannot be reused is disassembled using an optimal mix of physical and mechanical demanufacturing techniques to separate out hazardous materials from recyclable components. Disassembled commodities are sent to appropriate markets and processors for final treatment, with no hazardous waste being shipped to developing countries.

Customer Profile – When a company or institution would rather focus on supporting their IT infrastructure than dealing with the disposition of old equipment, Cascade is a great fit. Customers trust that Cascade will safeguard their sensitive data, maximize value of resalable equipment, and meet their regulatory obligations (environmental and privacy) by acting as a one-stop shop in "cascading" their IT equipment to its next best use. The company focuses on industries which value privacy and environmental compliance and generate a good mix of resalable IT assets. Cascade is strong in the insurance, financial, health care, manufacturing and government sectors. Cascade's current active client base includes about 450 institutions. No one customer accounts for more than 10% of all processing service revenue.

**Service Footprint** – While Cascade's processing facilities are located in the Midwest, our customer service footprint spans the United States and Puerto Rico. During 2019, Cascade collected equipment 31 states across America.
