Examines machines and mechanical equipment to diagnose trouble and complete repairs or to complete scheduled or unscheduled preventative maintenance. Journeyman Mechanics are responsible for identifying and ordering replacement parts and materials. They report to management or assigned supervisors conditions or required maintenance/repairs and may assist in preparation of specifications for major repairs. Education/Experience: High School Diploma and 5 years' experience in plumbing, electrical, HVAC and/or mechanical equipment field or equivalent jurisdiction licensing; outstanding work references and basic computer skills for emails and work order reporting; Journeyman Mechanics complete a formal apprenticeship or have equivalent on-the-job training and experience.</p>
<p>HELPER/APPRENTICE Responsible for maintenance and repairs to mechanical equipment and building systems while training for advancement to skilled Mechanic or Engineer position. Assists one or more workers in the skilled maintenance trades by performing specific or general duties of lesser skill as directed by Journeyman Mechanic or Operating Engineer. HVAC Technician should also have outstanding work references and basic computer skills for emails and Work Order Reporting; HVAC Technicians are required to complete a formal apprenticeship or have equivalent on-the-job training as well as being licensed.</p>
<p>HVAC JOURNEYMAN MECHANIC On-site responsibility for maintenance and repairs to HVAC equipment and systems. Education/Experience: High School Diploma and 2 years' experience in the HVAC field. HVAC Journeyman Mechanic should also have outstanding work references and basic computer skills for emails and Work Order reporting; HVAC Journeymen complete a formal apprenticeship or have equivalent on-the-job training and experience in accordance with being licensed.</p>
<p>JOURNEYMAN ELECTRICIAN Responsible for installation, maintenance, or repair of equipment for the generation, distribution, or utilization of electric energy. Education/Experience: High School Diploma and 5 years' experience in the electrical maintenance and installation field or equivalent jurisdiction licensing; outstanding work references and basic computer skills for emails and Work Order reporting; Journeyman Electricians complete a formal apprenticeship or have equivalent on-the-job training, as well as are licensed.</p>
