CONSULTING PROFESSIONAL FORESTER:

- **Functional Responsibilities:** A forester provides a wide range of services relating to timber and forest management. They may consult on problems including land use, pest control and tax issues, and they may produce environmental impact statements, boundary surveys, damage estimates and expert testimony for litigation.
- **Minimum Years of Experience:** 4
- **Minimum Educational/Degree Requirements:** A.S. Degree in Forestry
- **Applicable Training or Certification Requirements:** CA Registered Professional Forester / ISA Certified Arborist. Must possess a valid CA Commercial Driver License.

UTILITY FORESTER:

- **Functional Responsibilities:** Patrols distribution and/or transmission circuits (electrical/gas/water) and prescribes work to be performed by utility’s tree trimming contractor. Notifies property owners of tree trimming and tree and brush removal work to be performed relating to utility’s specifications. When necessary, obtains permits from public agencies and documents work. Audits tree trimming and tree removal work completed by the tree trimming contractor in the field to ensure compliance with work request forms and approved tree trimming standards. Other related duties as required.
- **Minimum Years of Experience:** 3
- **Minimum Educational/Degree Requirements:** A.S. Degree in Urban Forestry/Forestry/Natural Resources or 2 years of on the job experience working under the direction of an ISA Certified Utility Forester.
- **Applicable Training or Certification Requirements:** ISA Certified Arborist Utility Specialist. Must possess a valid CA Commercial Driver License.

ARBORIST:

- **Functional Responsibilities:** Duties include responsibility for all utility vegetation management activities and programs at the utility company, such as electrical line clearance, tree maintenance, advising clients on suitable tree species in areas near power lines, etc. The Arborist works under the direction of a Utility Forester or Consulting Professional Forester.
- **Minimum Years of Experience:** 2
- **Minimum Educational/Degree Requirements:** Must possess a High School diploma, GED or equivalent work experience.
- **Applicable Training or Certification Requirements:** ISA Certified Arborist. Must possess a valid CA Commercial Driver License.

FIELD SUPERVISOR:

- **Functional Responsibilities:** A field supervisor is responsible for the safe, efficient, and economic utilization of manpower, equipment, tools, and material(s) required for trimming and removing trees around or in proximity to electric transmission facilities.
The field supervisor schedules work, coordinates and assigns manpower, equipment, tools, and material(s) required for efficient and timely completion of the work. The field supervisor provides the work location and schedule of each crew as assigned by MFE. The field supervisor determines manpower, equipment, tools, material(s), and coordination necessary for the safe and efficient completion of work. Submit necessary reports in a timely and legible manner.
The field supervisor performs periodic field review of work in progress to ensure compliance with minimum clearance requirements, work standards, planned work procedures, and efficient utilization of manpower, equipment, tools, and material(s). The field supervisor assures that personnel are properly trained to perform the work proficiently and safely as to comply with all applicable laws, regulations, and local ordinances and to adhere to the requirements and intent of this contract.
- **Minimum Years of Experience:** 7 years of experience in line clearance work.
- **Minimum Educational/Degree Requirements:** Preferred high school graduate.
- **Applicable Training or Certification Requirements:** ISA Certified Arborist/Passed MFE's Line Clearance Qualification for Foreperson. Must possess a valid CA Commercial Driver License.

FOREMAN:

- **Functional Responsibilities:** A foreman is responsible for the safe execution and quality of the assigned work, actions of their crews, caring for the equipment, proper filing of necessary reports, giving instruction and training, and serving as MFE's contact with the general public. The foreman shall be present at the worksite at all times while work is being performed under this contract. The foreman shall be responsible for calling the utility's Dispatch (if required) at the start and finish of each day's activities.
The foreman is responsible for coordinating the work crew and ensuring that job safety briefings, tailgate meetings, and job requirements are clear and made available to all crew members under his/her direction.

Operate aerial lift trucks, dump trucks, chippers, winches and other vehicles and equipment. Complete paperwork associated with job functions in a neat and timely manner.

The foreman shall ensure that all pruning cuts shall be made in an arboriculturally correct manner and vegetation management practices shall be performed according to the International Society of Arboriculture (ISA) and ANSI standards. Train Line Clearance Tree Trimmer Trainees and other personnel in job-related operations.

- **Minimum Years of Experience:** 5 years of experience in line clearance work
- **Minimum Educational/Degree Requirements:** Must possess a High School diploma, GED or equivalent work experience.
- **Applicable Training or Certification Requirements:** ISA Certified Arborist/Passed MFE's Line Clearance Qualification for Foreperson. Must possess a valid CA Commercial Driver License.

EQUIPMENT OPERATOR:

- **Functional Responsibilities:** Under general supervision of a foreman performs a variety of semi-skilled and skilled work in the operation of light, medium and some heavy equipment and light to heavy duty trucks. The equipment operator performs required manual labor in tree work and construction and maintenance projects; checks and services assigned equipment.

Performs routine maintenance and emergency repairs, reports complex mechanical problems for shop repairs.

Performs other related duties as assigned for the purpose of ensuring the efficient and effective functioning of the work unit. May function as a foreman, on a limited basis.

- **Minimum Years of Experience:** 0.5 years of job related experience is required
- **Minimum Educational/Degree Requirements:** Must possess a High School diploma, GED or equivalent work experience.
- **Applicable Training or Certification Requirements:** Passed MFE's Line Clearance Qualification for Specialized Equipment Operator. Must possess a valid CA Commercial Driver License.

LINE CLEARANCE TREE TRIMMER:

- **Functional Responsibilities:** Under the supervision of the Foreman, this employee works as part of the utility tree crew to remove trees and brush near and around high voltage power lines, maintaining adequate clearances on all rights-of-way. Prepare and clean up tree crew work areas, including raking and sweeping debris from the tree trimming operation. Be acutely aware of safety requirements and keep a safe work area, free of hazards. Deal with customers and with the public in a pleasant, courteous and respectful manner. Properly care for and account for all assigned tools and materials. Train Line Clearance Tree Trimmer Trainees and other personnel in job-related operations. Perform other related duties as required.

Some of their tools include: chain saws, hand saws, pole pruners, ropes, rope blocks, rope climbing saddles, chippers and aerial lift equipment.

Complete paperwork associated with job functions in a neat and timely manner.

- **Minimum Years of Experience:** Must have a minimum of 1.6 years job experience trimming trees near high voltage power lines, as a Line Clearance Tree Trimmer Trainee.

- **Minimum Educational/Degree Requirements:** Must possess a High School diploma, GED or equivalent work experience.
- **Applicable Training or Certification Requirements:** Passed MFE's Line Clearance Qualification for Climber Trimmer.

LINE CLEARANCE TREE TRIMMER TRAINEE:

- **Functional Responsibilities:** Under the supervision of the line clearance tree trimmer/crew leader, this employee works as part of the utility tree crew to remove trees and brush near and around high voltage power lines, maintaining adequate clearances on all rights-of-way. Prepare and clean up tree crew work areas, including raking and sweeping debris from the tree trimming operation. Be acutely aware of safety requirements and keep a safe work area, free of hazards. Perform other related duties as required. Some of their tools include: chain saws, hand saws, pole pruners, ropes, rope blocks, rope climbing saddles, chippers and aerial lift equipment.
- **Minimum Years of Experience:** Must have a minimum of a ¼ year of job experience in utility tree trimming near high voltage power lines, as a Groundman/Flagman.
- **Minimum Educational/Degree Requirements:** N/A.
- **Applicable Training or Certification Requirements:** Passed MFE's Line Clearance Qualification for Trimmer Trainee.

GROUNDMAN/FLAGMAN:

- **Functional Responsibilities:** A groundman shall be defined as a crew member working under the supervision of the foreman. The groundman position is a support and technician level job that entails close observance of all safety issues involved in tree work as well as skills that support the work performed by the tree crew, allowing a smooth flow of productivity at the job-site. The groundman will be the point person preparing to load the appropriate tools for specific jobs for departure from the shop. The groundman performs duties under the direct supervision of the foreman such as, but not limited to: defining the staging area and safe zones on the jobsite and laying out the tools for the job, brushing, raking, digging, loading brush, clearing the ROW and controlling traffic, and filling equipment with gasoline or diesel while being mindful of safe handling of fuels.
- **Minimum Years of Experience:** 0, on the job training.
- **Minimum Educational/Degree Requirements:** N/A.
- **Applicable Training or Certification Requirements:** Passed MFE's Line Clearance Qualification for Groundpersons.

GROUND PERSONNEL:

- **Functional Responsibilities:** Can be part of a brushing crew that performs a variety of assignments that may associated with power line rights-of-ways, forestry improvement projects, and fuels reductions projects using a chainsaw or other tools to safely cut small trees and brush. Work may entail hand-piling of slash, relocation of slash, lop and scatter of slash, and/or chipping of slash.

A ground person may also assist a heavy equipment operator. A minimum of one experienced ground person shall be assigned at all times by MFE for each masticator machine. This person can assist the equipment operator with distance measurements (such as tree to line) and bucking and processing material that the machine is unable to reach; such as close to a structure or a stream.

- **Minimum Years of Experience:** 0, on the job training.
- **Minimum Educational/Degree Requirements:** N/A.
- **Applicable Training or Certification Requirements:** Passed MFE's Line Clearance Qualification for Groundpersons.

HERBICIDE APPLICATOR:

- **Functional Responsibilities:** An herbicide applicator shall be defined as a crew member working under the supervision of the foreman. An herbicide applicator fill sprayer tanks with water and chemicals, according to formulas and applies them through sprays, dusts, or vapors onto brush or trees. Cleans or services spray equipment to ensure operating efficiency. Cover areas to specified depths with herbicides, applying knowledge of weather conditions, droplet sizes, elevation-to-distance ratios, and obstructions.
- **Minimum Years of Experience:** 0.25
- **Minimum Educational/Degree Requirements:** N/A.
- **Applicable Training or Certification Requirements:** Passed MFE's Line Clearance Qualification for Groundpersons. Trained as pesticide applicators and in the use of backpack sprayers utilizing non-restricted chemicals.

FIREWATCH:

- **Functional Responsibilities:** The sole purpose of a firewatch is the monitoring of the fire index and watching the operations for fire ignition and controlling fire hazards, detecting early signs of unwanted fire, raising an alarm of fire and notifying the fire department.
The fire watch is responsible for monitoring the humidity level and cease operations if the humidity gets below 20 percent and/or the wind speed is above 10 MPH.
Fire Watch personnel should not perform firefighting duties beyond the scope of an ordinary person.
- **Minimum Years of Experience:** 0, on the job training.
