Our comprehensive auditing program is designed to maximize the quality of coding, billing and payment errors through the performance of regular and periodic audits of medical records, payor contracts and claims data. Our quality



control process provides continuous quality feedback to our customers to ensure a high standard level for coding and billing accuracy. BTL provides Medical Record Reviews, Medical Records Coding, Third Party Billing expertise and related healthcare services. We provided these services for extensive backlog coding, outpatient data validation, concurrent clinic review and education for providers, coders and billers.

BTL uses skills and knowledge of ICD-9-CM, CPT-4, HCPCS Level II and other generally accepted available resources to review medical record documentation and providers' scope of practice to assign diagnostic and procedural codes at a minimum 95% accuracy rate. BTL abstracts other identified data items and either enter the data into the local medical records system or write the information on source documents as agreed with the customer facility. This information includes a decision as to whether or not an episode is billable, based on the documentation and VHA billing guidelines, and the type of insurance coverage of the patient.

Reviews publications and available information sources to ensure the most current guidelines are followed.

Qualifications: High school diploma or equivalent required. Completion of and continuing certification for at least one recognized coding certificate program CPC, CPC-H, CCS or CCS-P. Multiple certifications preferred.

Coding and Compliance Auditor
