Tourniquets must be applied with realistic force to control hemorrhaging and responders can use field techniques such as hand, knee and elbow pressure on arterial pressure points to stop the simulated bleeding. TraumaFX products' unparalleled ruggedness allows them to be carried and dragged through inhospitable field training environments without damage, making it ideally suited for use in Care Under Fire and Combat Lifesaver training courses.

MATT is the first anthropomorphic trauma simulator to implement animatronic movement of injured limbs, significantly increasing the realism and appropriate difficulty of treatment. Extraordinary realism provides students with critical desensitization to traumatic amputation injuries allowing Medics,



Corpsmen, Soldiers, and other first responders to perform life saving tasks more efficiently and effectively in the field, leading to significant improvement in the treatment of blast injuries and saving lives. Every demonstration site has been impressed with MATT's realism, ruggedness and training features, as a complement to existing physiological training manikins. The first limited production run of MATT units was completed late 2009. MATT has since received consistent customer request for rapid deployment to the field.

With unmatched and unique features and characteristics in comparison to other simulators in today's marketplace, MATT has already received national accolades. In 2008, MATT was selected as the best development project from the US Army Research, Development, and Engineering Command's Simulation Training Technology Center (RDECOM-STTC). MATT also received the "2009 Training Modeling & Simulation Award for "Army-wide Team Training" awarded by the Deputy Chief of Staff of the Army, G-8. ## 9 KGS TRAUMAFX® WARRANTY INFORMATION

### TraumaFX® Products

#### LIMITED WARRANTIES

##### 1. LIMITED WARRANTY OVERVIEW

The TraumaFX products are comprised of two major components – internal ‘hardware’ and a silicone outer ‘skin’. Due to the unique characteristics of each of these components, KGS has implemented separate warranty terms and conditions for each:

- i. One (1) year limited hardware warranty.
- ii. One (1) year limited skin warranty.

##### 2. LIMITED HARDWARE WARRANTY

KGS warrants to customer, subject to the limitations and disclaimers specified below, that hardware will be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use for a period of one (1) year from the date of delivery to the customer. The date of delivery will be determined as two weeks from KGS’ recorded date of shipment to the customer. This Limited Hardware Warranty extends only to the customer who was the original purchaser of the hardware (the ‘Customer’) and may not be transferred to any person or entity.

This Limited Hardware Warranty does not apply if hardware (a) is altered from its original configuration at the time of purchase, (b) is installed, configured, implemented or operated in any way that is contrary to its documentation, (c) is damaged resulting from negligence, accident, environmental stress (e.g., exposure excessive heat, cold, humidity or moisture) or handling inconsistent with the handling that a human trauma patient should receive; (d) was subject to unauthorized repair or modification, (e) if customer failed to perform required preventive maintenance as described in Appendix A of this Limited Warranty, or (f) if non-TraumaFX simulated blood mix is used in or on the unit/system. A schedule of maintenance must be maintained and a copy provided to KGS for all warranty claims.

KGS products are designed using durable materials and exacting design and quality control specifications to ensure unsurpassed field durability and reliability. However, as with any ‘consumable’ training device, over time, the product will wear down with use, will no longer be able to be refurbished or repaired, and will require replacement by purchasing a new device.

##### 3. LIMITED SKIN WARRANTY

KGS warrants to the customer, subject to the limitations and disclaimers specified below, and separate and distinct from the one (1) year warranty granted above, that for a period of one (1) year from the date of delivery to the customer the skin will be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use.

This Limited Skin Warranty applies if and only if the skin is examined and refurbished as necessary after every training course, as detailed in Appendix A. This refurbishment operation takes only a few minutes but is mandatory to ensure maximized, uninterrupted use of any TraumaFX unit (e.g. MATT, APL, APL-IP, APL-PB, APL-AE, HEMO, and ACE) and task trainers. A schedule of maintenance must be maintained and a copy provided to KGS for all warranty claims.

As a guiding principle, the TraumaFX Product skin is designed for rugged use and many tourniquet applications. However, the customer should always keep in mind that the skin is not impervious to damage; TraumaFX products must be treated with similar care that would be provided to a human trauma patient. For example, dragging a TraumaFX Product and its

unprotected skin over sharp objects will result in damage to the skin, as it would on an actual patient. Damage caused by such action is not covered by this warranty. This Limited Skin Warranty extends only to the customer who was the original purchaser of a TraumaFX Product (the "Customer") and may not be transferred to any person or entity.

#### **4. REMEDIES**

Should the TraumaFX unit require service during the warranty period or while covered under a maintenance contract, it will be repaired or replaced at the discretion of KGS. KGS will provide a quote for repair or replacement of TraumaFX Product hardware that is out of warranty.

During the Limited Warranty period, upon proper notice to KGS by Customer, KGS will, at its sole option, either:

- a. Repair defective skin or hardware, or
- b. Replace defective skin or hardware with a new or refurbished component, or
- c. Replace defective skin or hardware with a different but functionally equivalent component, or
- d. Refund a portion of the purchase price, prorated for time elapsed during the one (1) year warranty period, e.g., if there are three months remaining on the warranty, the refund would be 25% of the original purchase price.

#### **5. REPAIR OF A TRAUMAFX PRODUCT / ASSOCIATED HARDWARE UNDER THE LIMITED WARRANTIES**

In the event of a service issue with a TraumaFX Product, please contact KGS Customer Support at 1-800-200-7465 or MATTSUPPORT@kforcegov.com. Frequently, issues can be easily resolved over the phone. Should it be determined that the unit must be returned to a KGS designated repair facility, a Return Material Authorization (RMA) number must be approved and obtained. This RMA number is necessary to ensure proper tracking and handling of returned material. Do not return the TraumaFX product or associated component hardware to KGS until an RMA is issued. KGS reserves the right to refuse shipments that do not have an RMA number. Refused shipments will be returned to the shipper via collect freight.

The customer is responsible for shipping RMA authorized components or TraumaFX Product units to an authorized KGS repair facility. Once an RMA has been issued, it must be shipped to the specified repair facility in a TraumaFX storage case. Items shipped using any other packaging will be rejected. Warranty claims are generally processed and completed within 30 days, subject to the availability of materials.

RMA units receive a ninety (90) day hardware warranty on the repaired component(s), or the remainder of the original or extended hardware warranty contract, whichever is longer.

If product malfunction(s) is/are determined to be caused from (a) alterations in any way from the original configuration as delivered at the time of purchase, (b) installation, configuration, implementation or operation in any way that is contrary to the original documentation provided with a TraumaFX Product at the time of purchase, (c) damage resulting from negligence, accident, or excessive environmental abuse, (d) unauthorized repair or modification, or (e) failure by customer to perform required preventive maintenance as described in Appendix A of this Warranty document, the customer will be provided with a cost and time estimate for repair.

The foregoing shall be the sole and exclusive remedies for breach of the Limited Warranty, Limited Skin Warranty or Limited Hardware Warranty provided herein (collectively, "Limited Warranties").

## 6. WARRANTY DISCLAIMER

KGS does not warrant or represent that the TraumaFX Product is error free or will operate without problems or disruptions.

**EXCEPT AS SET FORTH ABOVE, KGS MAKES NO WARRANTIES, WHETHER EXPRESS, IMPLIED, OR STATUTORY, REGARDING OR RELATING TO THE TRAUMAFX PRODUCT, THE SKIN OR ANY HARDWARE COVERED UNDER THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE LIMITED WARRANTIES PROVIDED HEREIN. KGS SPECIFICALLY DISCLAIMS ALL IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE REGARDING OR RELATING TO THE TRAUMAFX PRODUCT, THE SKIN OR ANY HARDWARE COVERED UNDER THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE LIMITED WARRANTIES PROVIDED HEREIN.**

## 7. LIMITATION OF LIABILITIES

**IN NO EVENT WILL KGS, OR ITS AUTHORIZED RESELLERS, BE LIABLE FOR ANY LOSS OF PROFITS, LOSS OF USE, BUSINESS INTERRUPTION, LOSS OF DATA, COST OF COVER OR INDIRECT, SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL, PUNITIVE OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES OF ANY KIND IN CONNECTION WITH OR ARISING OUT OF THE FURNISHING, PERFORMANCE OR USE OF THE TRAUMAFX PRODUCT, WHETHER ALLEGED AS A BREACH OF CONTRACT OR TORTIOUS CONDUCT, EVEN IF KGS HAS BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES. IN ADDITION, KGS, OR ITS AUTHORIZED RESELLERS, WILL NOT BE LIABLE FOR ANY DAMAGES CAUSED BY DELAY IN DELIVERY OR FURNISHING OF THE TRAUMAFX PRODUCT COVERED UNDER THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THIS WARRANTY. IN ANY EVENT, KGS' LIABILITY UNDER THIS AGREEMENT FOR DAMAGES WILL NOT EXCEED THE ACTUAL FEE PAID BY CUSTOMER TO KGS FOR THE SINGLE TRAUMAFX PRODUCT GIVING RISE TO SUCH LIABILITY. THIS DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY FOR DAMAGES WILL NOT BE AFFECTED BY ANY FAILURE OF ANY REMEDIES HEREUNDER. THIS PROVISION IS ENFORCEABLE TO THE EXTENT PERMITTED BY APPLICABLE LAW.**

## 8. WARRANTY REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE SERVICE PLANS

By mutual agreement between Customer and KGS, KGS may conduct warranty repairs during regularly scheduled on-site visit (quarterly, bi-annually, or annually), as covered by a KGS maintenance service plan.

## 9. MISCELLANEOUS

This Limited Warranty shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Virginia without reference to that State's conflict of laws rules and as if the contract was wholly formed within the State of Virginia. Customer agrees that sole and exclusive jurisdiction and venue shall be in Circuit Court in Fairfax, Virginia. Under no circumstances shall the United Nations Convention on the International Sale of Goods be considered for redress of grievances or adjudication of any warranty disputes that include the KGS TraumaFX Product. If any provision of this Limited Warranty is invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any respect, such provision shall be enforced to the maximum extent permissible so as to affect the intent of the parties, and the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect as if the invalid, illegal, or unenforceable provision or provisions were originally deleted.

## 10 KGS TRAUMAFX® MAINTENANCE/ANNUAL REPAIR SERVICE INFORMATION

### 1. Overview

KGS is dedicated to the continued success of life-saving training for our customers involved in trauma response. TraumaFX® products are designed using very durable materials and exacting design and quality control specifications to ensure unsurpassed field durability and reliability. However, as with any ‘consumable’ training device, over time, these product will require maintenance to ensure they remain in effective operating condition. Customer preventive maintenance between training sessions is recommended and required under the terms of the limited warranty to keep TraumaFX products working optimally. In addition, KGS provides both preventive and corrective maintenance services for TraumaFX units.

Maintenance support is provided through the following programs: Customer preventive maintenance, for fee KGS inspection and preventive maintenance services, annual repair service, and warranty repairs. TraumaFX units are designed for rugged use in realistic environments, but may eventually experience a component failure as a result of normal ‘wear and tear’. Regular, careful preventive maintenance and frequent after-use inspection will extend the service life of these systems. The combination of frequent inspection with KGS’ warranty coverage will ensure satisfactory long-term training use of these systems.

### 2. Maintenance Service Levels

Proper care will keep TraumaFX units operating optimally. This includes Customer Preventive Maintenance, combined with KGS’ *Essential Care Maintenance Service*, *Advantage Care Maintenance Service*, the *Premium Care Maintenance Service* or *Annual Repair Service* for out of warranty units.

#### 2.1 Customer Preventive Maintenance

Customers must perform the required preventive maintenance actions described in detail in Appendix A of this Maintenance Guide after each training session to keep a TraumaFX unit operating as designed. Completing these easy to perform actions after each training session will help ensure that it remains in peak operating condition for future training sessions.

#### 2.2 Essential Care

Customers may purchase specialized maintenance services from KGS to complement their own preventive maintenance services. KGS’ Essential Care Maintenance Service provides additional product maintenance actions performed by a certified KGS maintenance technician, designed to help keep a TraumaFX unit operating at peak efficiency during the normal operating life cycle of this product.

Essential Care provides one annual maintenance visit by a KGS technician to provide on-site inspection and limited replacement/repair of damaged parts identified during detailed inspection that are covered under the TraumaFX product warranty. It is designed to augment Customer Preventive Maintenance by ensuring that each unit is properly cleaned and problem areas proactively identified and repaired before failure can occur. During on-site inspection, any parts that demonstrate failure or potential failure will be recommended for replacement. Replacement of parts is subject to the terms of the KGS TraumaFX Warranty. Labor is included in any on-site KGS maintenance service. However, the cost of repair parts is subject to warranty provisions. The on-site preventive maintenance actions performed during the Essential Care maintenance service are described in detail in Appendix B of this Maintenance Program Guide.

### **2.3 Advantage Care**

KGS' Advantage Care Maintenance Service provides additional product maintenance actions performed by a certified KGS technician to help keep a TraumaFX product operating at peak efficiency during the normal operating life cycle of this product. It provides two on-site maintenance visits per year. Performing these maintenance actions at an increased frequency provides inspection that is more frequent and refurbishment to ensure maximized availability of a TraumaFX training systems.

Advantage Care provides two on-site maintenance visits by a certified KGS technician to complete on-site inspection and limited replacement/repair of damaged parts covered under the TraumaFX product warranty. These maintenance visits augment Customer Preventive Maintenance by ensuring that each unit is properly cleaned and problem areas identified and repaired before failure can occur. During on-site inspection, any parts that demonstrate failure or potential failure are recommended for replacement. Replacement of parts is subject to the terms of the KGS TraumaFX warranty. Labor is included in any on-site KGS maintenance service. However, the cost of repair parts is subject to warranty provisions. The on-site preventive maintenance actions that will be performed as part of the Advantage Care maintenance service are described in detail in Appendix B of this Maintenance Program Guide.

### **2.4 Premium Care**

KGS' Premium Care Maintenance Service provides additional product maintenance actions performed by a certified KGS technician to help keep a TraumaFX unit operating at peak efficiency during the normal operating life cycle of this product. It provides four quarterly on-site maintenance visits instead of one. Performing these maintenance actions at an increased frequency provides inspection that is more frequent and refurbishment to ensure maximized availability of TraumaFX training systems.

Premium Care provides four quarterly on-site maintenance visits by a certified KGS technician to complete on-site inspection and limited replacement/repair of damaged parts covered under the TraumaFX product warranty. These maintenance visits augment Customer Preventive Maintenance by ensuring that each unit is properly cleaned and problem areas identified and repaired before failure can occur. During on-site inspection, any parts that demonstrate failure or potential failure are recommended for replacement. Replacement of parts is subject to the terms of the KGS TraumaFX warranty. Labor is included in any on-site KGS maintenance service. However, the cost of repair parts is subject to warranty provisions. The on-site preventive maintenance actions that will be performed as part of the Premium Care maintenance service are described in detail in Appendix B of this Maintenance Program Guide.

### **2.5 Annual Repair Service**

Annual Repair Service provides repair coverage for a single, out of warranty TraumaFX unit (upper or lower body) at a certified KGS repair facility. Units covered under this Annual Service Repair program are shipped via ground transport, inspected, repaired, and shipped via ground transport back to the customer. A covered unit must be shipped to the specified repair facility in a TraumaFX storage case. Items shipped using any other packaging will be rejected. Annual Repair Service claims are generally processed and completed within 30 days, subject to the availability of materials. During inspection, any parts that demonstrate failure or potential failure are replaced. These units receive a ninety (90) day hardware warranty on the repaired component(s), or the remainder of the original Annual Repair Service contract, whichever is longer.

### 3. Limitations of Maintenance

Because the ‘skin’ on TraumaFX products is a consumable item, replacement costs of this part are NOT included in the basic cost of KGS maintenance or annual service repair programs. Replacement of a damaged or worn-out ‘skin’ can be conducted during a scheduled maintenance visit, but the customer must notify KGS of this requirement and order replacement skins for the units that require a replacement of skin systems in advance of a planned on-site maintenance visit. The TraumaFX product skin can only be replaced by a certified KGS technician.

#### *Maintenance will not be performed on TraumaFX units that experience:*

- Damage caused by failure of Customer to follow KGS’ recommended maintenance or operating specifications
- Damage due to war, nuclear incident, or terrorism
- Damage due to unauthorized attempts to repair Equipment or Equipment previously repaired by an unauthorized technician or user
- Obsolescence, cosmetic damage, rust, change in color, texture or finish, wear and tear, gradual deterioration or any damage that does not affect functionality of the TraumaFX system
- Fraud, fire, theft, unexplained or mysterious disappearance, misuse, abuse or willful act
- Alteration or modification of the TraumaFX system in any way
- Transit or relocation of the TraumaFX system by the Customer including any damages occurring while in transit, or related to such relocation, and services accompanying or related to transit or relocation of the Equipment.

### 4. Customer Responsibilities

Customers are responsible for performing the preventive maintenance actions for TraumaFX units as described in this maintenance guide. Failure to perform the required preventive maintenance tasks on a timely basis will result in loss of warranty coverage, and may result in additional repair charges if it is determined that lack of basic preventive maintenance contributed to a TraumaFX product operational failure.

## Appendix A

### Required Customer Performed Maintenance Actions Post Training

The following preventive maintenance actions must be completed by customers after each training session to keep the TraumaFX system operating as designed. These easy to perform actions will help ensure that the TraumaFX system remains in peak operating condition for each training session:

- Wash skin and wounds with potable water after each day of use to clean skin and wounds. Blood paste is cellulose based and could attract insects if left on the TraumaFX lower or upper units.
- Flush the blood system with potable water daily and prior to storage lasting longer than one day.
- Empty the blood bladder daily either by running the pump dry or by connecting the blood fill bucket to the lower body and placing the bucket at a lower elevation than the lower body. This will prevent damage to the bladder from exposure to extreme heat or cold.
- If the skin is cut, then clean the cut with alcohol or with a silicone-approved cleaner that does not leave a residue. Allow the cut to thoroughly dry. Repair the cut using a silicone adhesive such as Sil-Poxy© by Smooth-On. Allow all repairs to fully cure prior to student use.
- Remove batteries daily after training is complete. Do not store batteries in the unit or in the transmitter as this could cause the batteries to fail.
- Replace and fully recharge batteries before each training exercise. Also replace and fully recharge the transmitter batteries prior to each training exercise. To extend the service life of the batteries, do not run the batteries until they are completely out of charge.
- Make sure that all batteries are 100% fully charged prior to use. Do not mix a fully charged battery with a partially charged battery as this will cause the unit to not operate properly.
- Only charge product-related batteries using the approved chargers supplied with the TraumaFX system.
- Read the User's Manual for the transmitter and follow instructions and precautions listed inside the manual.
- Read the User's Manual for the battery chargers and follow instructions and precautions listed inside the manual.

## Appendix B

### Essential Care, Advantage Care, and Premium Care Maintenance Services

Maintenance services that will be performed by a KGS maintenance technician during a scheduled, on-site *Essential Care, Advantage Care* or *Premium Care* maintenance visit include:

- The lower (and upper units where applicable) will be functionally tested and observed to ensure correct operating performance.
- The technician will test the radio control system for proper operation.
- The technician will test the battery chargers for proper operation. A battery will be charged while the technician is present to verify the charger takes an appropriate amount of time to charge a battery.
- The technician will fill the system with potable water to test the blood fill system to ensure the quick connect valves, filters, tubing, and blood bladder are all operating correctly.
- The blood pumping system will be examined to ensure the proper operation of the blood pump, solenoids, and pressure system.
- An examination of the pump timer circuit will be performed to ensure the system is pumping at an appropriate rate and for an appropriate duration.
- The technician will test tourniquet application to ensure the system functions as designed to effectively shut off the flow of blood.
- The technician will inspect the animatronics system to ensure the animatronics mechanisms are operating properly.
- The mechanical clutch system will be inspected and tested to ensure that the clutches are operating properly.
- The technician will inspect the outer skin surfaces to ensure that the skin is in good condition. Minor small tears or cuts will be repaired.
- The technician will flush the blood system with potable water.
- If the lower unit is behaving abnormally, at the discretion of the technician, the lower skin will be removed (degloved) to examine the interior, determine components requiring maintenance/repair, and replace/repair components as necessary per the terms and conditions of the TraumaFX warranty.
- If the lower unit is degloved, the blood tubing will be examined throughout the system.
- If the lower unit is degloved, the technician will also examine the interior core structure to ensure that all parts are in their proper place and that the system is operating correctly.
- The technician will re-assemble the lower unit system and fully re-test it to verify that it is operating properly after maintenance operations are completed.
