**DIRECT COLOR SYSTEMS**

**A - WHAT IS COVERED**

Direct Color Systems, (DCS) warrants to the original purchaser that the product enclosed with this Limited Warranty statement and used in the country of purchase will conform to the manufacturer's specifications and be free from defects in workmanship and materials for a period of one (1) year from the date of original purchase "as found on the installation report submitted to DCS". If no installation report is on file at DCS, the warranty period begins based on the date product was shipped from DCS. An extended warranty is available at additional cost. All service will take place at our Corporate Office. There is no on site service available.

#### **B - WHAT DCS WILL DO TO CORRECT PROBLEMS**

If you have any problems whatsoever, contact your local manufacturer's representative or DCS immediately. DCS will endeavor to fix the problem over the phone or by shipping replacement parts to you. If we cannot successfully fix your problem within 48 hours and you have owned your Millennium for less than 90 days, we will ship you a loaner machine (if available) at no charge while your unit is repaired. DCS will pay for freight in both directions. After this 90-day period, should your DCS Millennium malfunction, please call, fax or write DCS at the numbers and address listed below for service assistance. Customer will be responsible for freight charges in both directions.

#### **C - WHAT THIS WARRANTY DOES NOT COVER**

This warranty covers only normal office-environment use in the country of original purchase. Thermal print heads are warranted separately under the terms of Section D below. DCS is not responsible for warranty service should the DCS label or logo or the rating label or serial number be removed or should the product fail to be properly maintained or fail to function properly as a result of misuse, abuse, improper installation, neglect, duty cycle abuse, improper shipping, damage caused by disasters such as fire, flood, and lightning, improper electrical current, software problems, interaction with non-DCS products, or service other than by an Authorized agent. Duty cycle abuse is defined as operation of this printer beyond its nominal duty cycle; all repairs thereafter are to be billed on a time and materials basis. Postage, insurance, or shipping costs incurred in presenting your DCS Millennium for warranty service are your responsibility, except in the instance of the shipment costs on the replacement unit only, as outlined above.

If a claimed defect cannot be identified or reproduced in service, you will be held responsible for costs incurred. **IMPORTANT:** if using a mechanical switch box between this printer and another printer, be certain that it includes surge protection. Non-warranty damage to your printer could result from the use of unprotected switch boxes.

#### **D - PRINT HEAD WARRANTY**

DCS warrants that, under normal use and service, thermal print heads shall be free from defects in material and workmanship for a **pro-rated** period of one (1) year from the date of original purchase, provided that a DCS approved print media is utilized. In the event a warranty claim is submitted for a defective print head, DCS shall have the right to inspect the print head and your printed and/or blank media for the purpose of verifying that any such claimed defect has not been caused by non DCS approved media, by media that does not meet DCS's specifications, or by foreign particles or substances which have caused abrasion damage. The DCS's decision in any such claim shall be final. DCS shall not be held liable for the integrity and/or longevity of any text, photographic images, digitized images, holographic images, graphics, patterned overlays, bar codes, magnetic stripe encoding, or combination thereof that are produced, generated, or otherwise transferred to printable media by the use of the DCS Millennium, color byte™ software or supplies under this agreement. Once DCS has determined a print head to be defective, DCS will replace the print head "at no charge" during the first ninety (90) days. For the remaining balance of the warranty year, the printhead will

be replaced at a cost to the customer of 50% off of current list price.

This warranty and remedy provided above are exclusive and in lieu of all other warranties, either express or implied, including but not limited to implied warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose. Unless stated herein, any statements or representations made by any other person or firms are void. The duration of any warranties, either express or implied, including but not limited to implied warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose, on your DCS Millennium shall be limited to the duration set forth above.

Neither direct color systems nor its affiliates shall be liable for any loss, inconvenience, or damage, including direct, special, incidental, or consequential damages, resulting from the use or inability to use the DCS Millennium, whether resulting from breach of warranty or any other legal theory even if DCS has been advised of the possibility of such damages. This Limited Warranty is governed by the laws of the State of Connecticut, United States of America, and the venue for resolution of any and all disputes shall be resolved in the county of DCS's principal place of business. Some states and/or countries do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts and some states and/or countries do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitation and exclusion may not apply to you. This warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other legal rights, which may vary, from state to state and/or country to country.

#### **NESCHEN AMERICAS (SEAL Graphics)**

Seal Graphics warrants to the original consumer purchaser that each new SEAL®, Image®, ProSEAL® or AquaSEAL® Laminator, which proves defective in materials or workmanship within the applicable **warranty** period, will be repaired or, at our option, replaced without charge.

Effective November 1st, 2002, the applicable **warranty** period for New Equipment shall be one year (parts), six months (labor and rollers) from date of purchase.

This **warranty** extends to and is enforceable by only the original consumer purchaser and only for the period (during the applicable term), which the product remains in the possession of the original consumer purchaser. "Original consumer purchaser" means the person who first purchased the product covered by this **warranty** other than for purpose of resale. This **warranty** does not apply if it is found that at any time the equipment has not been used for its intended purpose.

GBC's obligation under this limited warranty is limited to replacement or repair, at GBC's option, of any part found defective by GBC without charge for material or labor.

GBC's obligation under this limited warranty does not include routine maintenance, cleaning, adjustment, normal cosmetic or mechanical wear, or freight charges.

Without limiting the generality of the previous paragraph, GBC's obligation under this limited warranty does not include:

1. Damage caused to the rollers by knives, razors, or other sharp tools: by any foreign objects falling into the working area of the laminator; or by cleaning the laminator with solutions or materials that harm its surfaces;
2. Damage caused by adhesives; nor
3. Damage caused by lifting, tilting or attempting to position the laminator other than rolling it on its castors across even surfaces.
