3	Dispatcher	Assigns drivers and vehicles to convey freight or passengers. Requires a high school diploma with at least 4 years of experience in the field or in a related area. Familiar with a variety of the field's concepts, practices, and procedures. Relies on experience and judgment to plan and accomplish goals. Performs a variety of complicated tasks. May direct and lead the work of others. Typically reports to a manager or head of a unit/department. A wide degree of creativity and latitude is expected.
4	Drivers 1	This individual is a Non-CDL licensed driver. May be licensed to operate a bus. Licensing requirements depend on the state. Must have a "satisfactory" driving record. Driver transports using agency provided vehicle or company owned vehicle. The Driver transport clients or company personnel; drives vehicle from central loading area to destination according to the assigned schedule. Relies on instructions and pre-established guidelines to perform the functions of the job.
