Conditions of Carriage

1. It is mutually agreed that the shipment described on the reverse hereof is accepted on the date hereof in apparent good order (except as noted) for carriage as specified herein subject to these terms and conditions hereto described.
2. As used in this contract, "Forwarder" means Sterling Courier Systems, Inc., and its authorized agents.
3. In tendering the shipment for carriage, the shipper warrants that the shipment is packaged to protect the enclosed goods and to insure safe transportation with ordinary care in handling, and that each package is appropriately labeled and is in good order for carriage as specified.
4. All shipments may, at the Forwarder's option, be opened and inspected.
5. Forwarder shall not be liable for any loss, damage, delay, mis-delivery, non-delivery, or other result not caused by its own negligence. In any event, Forwarder shall not be liable for loss, damage delay, or other results caused by **(a)** acts of God, public enemies, public authorities acting with actual or apparent authority, authority of law, quarantine, riots, strikes, civil commotions, or hazards or dangers incident to a state of way, **(b)** the act or default of the shipper or consignee, including any breach of the warranty set forth in Paragraph 3 above, **(c)** the nature of the shipment, or any defect, characteristic or inherent vice thereof, **(d)** violation by the shipper or consignee of any of these conditions of contract, **(e)** compliance or non-compliance with delivery or special instructions.
6. Forwarder shall not be liable for special or consequential damages.
7. In consideration of Forwarder's rate for the transportation of any shipment, which rate, in part is dependent upon the value of the shipment, the shipper and all other parties having any interest in the shipment agree that the limit of Forwarder's liability shall be the lesser of: **(a)** the amount of any damages actually sustained, or **(b)** whichever of the following is greater: **(1)** \$500.00 per shipment tendered, or **(2)** \$.50 per pound multiplied by the weight of the entire shipment, or **(3)** the value declared on the reverse hereof. Forwarder acts as self-insurer for liability amounts below \$250.00, and maintains insurance coverage for amounts in excess thereof.
8. In the event of the failure or inability of the consignee to take delivery of the shipment, Forwarder will notify shipper in writing at the address shown on the shipment and request disposition instructions. If the shipper fails to provide disposition instructions within 30 days after the date of Forwarder's notice, Forwarder will return the shipment to the shipper at the shipper's expense, If shipper fails to accept delivery of a shipment thus returned, Forwarder may, upon 30 days written notice to the shipper, dispose of the shipment as Forwarder sees fit.

Conditions of Carriage

9. Forwarder will exercise due diligence in routing shipment. Regardless of the method of transportation employed, the Forwarder's charges will apply.
10. Claims for loss or damage discovered by the consignee after delivery and after a clear receipt has been given to Forwarder must be reported in writing within 15 days after delivery of the shipment, with privilege to inspect the shipment and its container(s) and packing materials within 15 days after receipt of such notice. (On shipments to Puerto Rico, claims must be reported within 7 days after delivery.)
11. Claims for loss, damage, or delay must be made in writing within a period of 30 days after the date of acceptance of the shipment by the Forwarder. (On shipments to Puerto Rico, claims must be made within 120 days.)
12. Forwarder shall not be liable in any action unless a claim has been filed and such action is brought within 1 year after the date written notice is given to the claimant that Forwarder has disallowed the claim in full or in part. To the extent that it is not governed by Federal law, this Contract shall be construed and the performance of the transportation shall be determined in accordance with the laws of the State, in which the shipment is accepted by the Forwarder. If any provision of this Contract is determined to be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of the Contract shall not be affected thereby.
13. No agent, employee, or representative of Sterling Courier Systems, Inc. has the authority to modify any provision of this Contract.
