Medical Coach Services are provided with Mobility Assistance Vehicles (MAVs) specially designed and equipped for individuals with varying degrees of disability. Such services are designed to meet the special needs of those individuals who are wheelchair-bound or with crutches and those who receive Physical, Chemo- and/or Radio-therapy, Hemodialysis, and those with impaired vision and/or hearing. VMS also provides such services for non-medical purposes such as those required by airlines for handicapped passengers for inter-terminal and/or passenger connections. These MAVs are manned and operated by Mobility Assistance Vehicle Technicians (MAVTs) who are licensed by the New Jersey Department of Health and Senior Services (DOHSS).

Ambulance Services are provided with vehicles specially equipped with the requisite basic life support medical equipment and are manned by Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs). These technicians are medically trained and certified by the New Jersey DOHSS and the Office of Emergency Medical Service (OEMS) to provide Basic Life Support (BLS). Each ambulance is manned by two EMTs to respond promptly to emergency calls (911 or other) or to transport stretcher-bound patients.
