This express warranty is extended by USAlert LLC, 164 West Royal Palm Rd, Boca Raton, Florida 33432 to the original end user purchaser only and may not be assigned or transferred to any other party.

II. GENERAL PROVISIONS

This warranty sets forth the full extent of USAlert responsibilities regarding the pager. Repair, replacement, or refund of the purchase price, at USAlert's option, is the exclusive remedy. THIS WARRANTY IS GIVEN IN LIEU OF ALL OTHER EXPRESS WARRANTIES. IMPLIED WARRANTIES, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION, IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE ARE LIMITED TO THE DURATION OF THIS LIMITED WARRANTY. IN NO EVENT SHALL USALERT BE LIABLE FOR DAMAGES IN EXCESS OF THE PURCHASE PRICE OF THE USALERT PAGER, FOR ANY LOSS OF USE, LOSS OF TIME, INCONVENIENCE, COMMERCIAL LOSS, LOST PROFITS OR SAVINGS OR OTHER INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES ARISING OUT OF THE USE OR INABILITY TO USE SUCH PRODUCT, TO THE FULL EXTENT SUCH MAY BE DISCLAIMED BY LAW.

USAlert pagers, except Watchdogs, are shipped from the factory with a standard limited warranty of one year parts and labor from date of purchase based on proof of purchase. Watchdog pagers are shipped with a five year factory warranty. In the event of a defect, malfunction, or failure to conform to specifications during the warranty period, at its option, will repair, replace or refund the purchase price of the pager. Repair, at USAlert option, may include the replacement of parts or boards with functionally equivalent reconditioned or new parts or boards. Replaced parts and boards are warranted for the balance of the original warranty period. All parts and boards removed in the replacement process shall become the property of USAlert. This warranty does not cover water damage, physical damage, defects, malfunctions, performance failures or damages to the unit resulting from use in other than its normal and customary manner; misuse, accident or neglect, the use of non-conforming parts, or improper alterations or repairs. This warranty does not cover batteries, battery chargers, housings or holsters, wear and tear on covers and coverage or range over which the pager will receive signals. Unauthorized disassembly of the paging product or repairs of any kind by anyone other than a USAlert authorized pager service center will void this warranty.

IV. OPTIONAL EXPRESS MAINTENANCE WARRANTY FOR WATCHDOG, NOVA PAGERS AND UNICATION PAGERS

As of 7/26/07, This optional extended warranty covers parts and labor for the number of years chosen starting at the time of shipment from the manufacturing facility and covers the warranty in Section III.

Not included in the extended warranty coverage are: Incomplete pagers, such as ones in which the boards are missing and or incompatible, pagers whose serial numbers do not match on the boards and/or do not match the serial number on the housing or pagers that have had work performed by anyone other than a USAlert authorized pager service center. The intended purpose of extended warranty coverage is to repair or replace pagers that have been damaged or fail during normal use. It is not intended to cover pagers assembled from scrap or from non-working boards. Unauthorized disassembly of the paging product or repairs of any kind by anyone other than a USAlert authorized pager service center will void this warranty.
