**TERMS AND CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO PURCHASE OF  
GENERAL PURPOSE COMMERCIAL INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY EQUIPMENT  
(SPECIAL ITEM NUMBER 132-8)**

**1. MATERIAL AND WORKMANSHIP**

All equipment furnished hereunder must satisfactorily perform the function for which it is intended.

**2. ORDER**

Written orders, EDI orders (GSA Advantage! and FACNET), credit card orders, and orders placed under blanket purchase agreements (BPA) agreements shall be the basis for purchase in accordance with the provisions of this contract. If time of delivery extends beyond the expiration date of the contract, the Contractor will be obligated to meet the delivery and installation date specified in the original order.

For credit card orders and BPAs, telephone orders are permissible.

**3. TRANSPORTATION OF EQUIPMENT**

FOB DESTINATION. Prices cover equipment delivery to destination, for any location within the geographic scope of this contract.

**4. INSTALLATION AND TECHNICAL SERVICES**

a. **INSTALLATION.** When the equipment provided under this contract is not normally self-installable, the Contractor's technical personnel shall be available to the ordering activity, at the ordering activity's location, to install the equipment and to train ordering activity personnel in the use and maintenance of the equipment. The charges, if any, for such services are listed below, or in the price schedule:

Nurse Call Systems are not normally self-installable; they are installed either directly by the factory or by a factory-authorized distributor who is factory-trained to do so. Costs for installation vary by area of the country, however costs are never to exceed \$95 per hour which is the cost in the bay area of California. Installation costs in southern and mid-western regions of the United States are lower, as the cost for skilled labor is less.

The ordering activity reserves the right to inspect or test any equipment that has been tendered for acceptance. The ordering activity may require repair or replacement of nonconforming equipment at no increase in contract price. The ordering activity must exercise its postacceptance rights (1) within a reasonable time after the defect was discovered

or should have been discovered; and (2) before any substantial change occurs in the condition of the item, unless the change is due to the defect in the item.

## 6. WARRANTY

a. Unless specified otherwise in this contract, the Contractor's standard commercial warranty as stated in the contract's commercial pricelist will apply to this contract.

Commencing with the shipment date of the complete order and continuing for a period of five years, West-Com Nurse Call Systems, Inc. warrants that under normal use, each product sold and purchased hereunder that is manufactured by West-Com Nurse Call Systems, Inc. shall be free from manufacturing defects of material and workmanship.

All products sold by West-Com Nurse Call Systems, Inc., but not manufactured by West-Com Nurse Call Systems, Inc. have their own manufacturer warranties. Pagers, for example, are warranted that under normal use, they shall be free from manufacturing defects of material and workmanship for a period of one year. Dell Computers, at this time, offer a three-year warranty. Strain reliefs, manufactured by Curbell, are warranted for a period of 90 days. Pillow speakers currently are warranted for two years.

West-Com Nurse Call System, Inc.'s sole obligation and Buyer's sole remedy under this warranty shall be limited to West-Com Nurse Call Systems, Inc.'s repairing or replacing, at its option, defective Product components thereof, when such are returned to West-Com Nurse Call Systems, Inc. freight prepaid. (Note: Warranty date may be extended if an extended warranty is purchased.)

The foregoing warranties are expressly in lieu of all other warranties, expressed or implied, including the implied warranty of merchantability and/or fitness for a particular purpose.

At no time shall West-Com Nurse Call Systems, Inc. be held liable for any labor costs related to any problems with Product supplied by West-Com Nurse Call Systems, Inc.

All warranties shall become null and void in the event that it is determined that someone has altered or modified any Product, used non-factory-supplied parts of products (dome lights, emergency stations, custom cable, etc.) without West-Com Nurse Call Systems, Inc.'s prior written authorization and/or if buyer or anyone failed to follow West-Com Nurse Call Systems, Inc.'s recommended installation procedures, instructions and/or color codes.

b. The Contractor warrants and implies that the items delivered hereunder are merchantable and fit for use for the particular purpose described in this contract.

c. **Limitation of Liability.** Except as otherwise provided by an express or implied warranty, the Contractor will not be liable to the ordering activity for consequential damages resulting from any defect or deficiencies in accepted items.

**7. PURCHASE PRICE FOR ORDERED EQUIPMENT**

The purchase price that the ordering activity will be charged will be the ordering activity purchase price in effect at the time of order placement, or the ordering activity purchase price in effect on the installation date (or delivery date when installation is not applicable), whichever is less.

**8. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE CONTRACTOR**

The Contractor shall comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations (Federal, State, City or otherwise) covering work of this character, and shall include all costs, if any, of such compliance in the prices quoted in this offer.

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**2 REPAIR SERVICE AND REPAIR PARTS/SPARE PARTS ORDERS**

a. Agencies may use written orders, EDI orders, credit card orders, blanket purchase agreements (BPAs), or small order procedures for ordering repair service and/or repair parts/spare parts under this contract. Orders for repair service shall not extend beyond the end of the contract period.

b. When repair service is ordered, only one chargeable repairman shall be dispatched to perform repair service, unless the ordering activity agrees, in advance, that additional repair personnel are required to effect repairs.

**3 LOSS OR DAMAGE**

When the Contractor removes equipment to his establishment for repairs, the Contractor shall be responsible for any damage or loss, from the time the equipment is removed from the ordering activity installation, until the equipment is returned to such installation.

**4 SCOPE**

a. The Contractor shall provide maintenance for all equipment listed herein, as requested by the ordering activity during the contract term. Repair service and repair parts/spare parts shall apply exclusively to the equipment types/models within the scope of this Information Technology Schedule.

b. Equipment placed under maintenance service shall be in good operating condition.

(1) In order to determine that the equipment is in good operating condition, the equipment shall be subject to inspection by the Contractor, without charge to the ordering activity.

(2) Costs of any repairs performed for the purpose of placing the equipment in good operating condition shall be borne by the Contractor, if the equipment was under the Contractor's guarantee/warranty or maintenance responsibility prior to the effective date of the maintenance order.

(3) If the equipment was not under the Contractor's responsibility, the costs necessary to place the equipment in proper operating condition are to be borne by the ordering activity, in accordance with the provisions of Special Item Number 132-12 (or outside the scope of this contract).

**5 RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE ORDERING ACTIVITY**

- a. Ordering activity personnel shall not perform maintenance or attempt repairs to equipment while such equipment is under the purview of a maintenance order, unless agreed to by the Contractor.
- b. Subject to security regulations, the ordering activity shall permit access to the equipment which is to be maintained or repaired.

**6 RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE CONTRACTOR**

For equipment not covered by a maintenance contract or warranty, the Contractor's repair service personnel shall complete repairs as soon as possible after notification by the ordering activity that service is required. Within the service areas, this repair service should normally be done within 4 hours after notification.

**7 REPAIR SERVICE RATE PROVISIONS**

a **CHARGES.** Charges for repair service will include the labor charge, computed at the rates set forth below, for the time during which repairmen are actually engaged in work, and, when applicable, the charge for travel or transportation.

b **MULTIPLE MACHINES.** When repairs are ordered by a ordering activity on two or more machines located in one or more buildings within walking distance of each other, the charges will be computed from the time the repairman commences work on the first machine, until the work is completed on the last machine. When repair service is requested to be performed during Regular Hours and/or After Hours, but is performed at the convenience of the Contractor on Sundays or Holidays observed at the ordering activity location, the Regular Hours and/or After Hours repair service rates, as applicable, shall apply.
