Systems Analyst I	BA + 2	The Systems Analyst I analyzes information requirements; evaluates analytically and systematically problems of workflows, organization, and planning and assists Senior Computer Systems Analyst and Computer Systems Analyst in the development of appropriate corrective actions; helps develop plans for automated information systems from project inception to conclusion; defines problems and develops system requirements and program specifications, from which programmers prepare detailed flow charts, programs, and tests; and develops, in conjunction with functional users, system alternative solutions; and, under the supervision of a Senior Systems Analyst, closely coordinates with programmers to ensure proper implementation of program and system specifications.
Systems Analyst II	BA + 3	The Systems Analyst II analyzes and develops computer software possessing a wide range of capabilities, including numerous engineering, business, and records management functions; develops plans for automated information systems from project inception to conclusion; analyzes the problem and the information to be processed; defines the problem, and develops system requirements and program specifications, from which programmers prepare detailed flow charts, programs, and tests; coordinates closely with programmers to ensure proper implementation of program and system specifications; and develops, in conjunction with functional users, system alternative solutions.
Systems Analyst III	BA + 7	The Systems Analyst III reviews, analyzes, and modifies programming systems including encoding, testing, debugging and installing to support an organization's application systems. Consults with users to identify current operating procedures and to clarify program objectives. May be expected to write documentation to describe program development, logic, coding, and corrections. Writes manuals for users to describe installation and operating procedures. Requires a bachelor's degree in a related area and at least 5 years of experience in the field or in a related area. Must have a working knowledge of relational databases and client-server concepts. Relies on experience and judgment to plan and accomplish

		goals. Performs a variety of complicated tasks. May lead and direct the work of others. Typically reports to a project leader or manager. A wide degree of creativity and latitude is expected.
Systems Analyst IV	BA + 10	The Systems Analyst IV applies analytical processes to the planning, design, and implementation of new and improved information systems to meet the organization's business requirements. The incumbent in this position develops overall functional and systems requirements and specifications; prepares business cases for the application of IT solutions; defines systems scope and objectives; develops cost estimates for new or modified systems; ensures the integration of all systems components (e.g., procedures, databases, policies, software, and hardware); plans systems implementations; and ensures the rigorous application of information security/information assurance policies, principles, and practices to the systems analysis process.
Network Operation Center (NOC) Technician	High School Diploma/GED + 5	The Network Operation Center (NOC) Technician conducts site surveys; assesses and documents current site network configuration and user requirements; participates in the design and optimization of network topologies; follows engineering plans and site installation technical design packages; works with network installation teams; assists in the preparation of drawing and documenting configuration changes at each site; and assists in the preparation of site installation and test reports. Provides first level guidance/direction (either as a full-time supervisory position or on a project management basis) to network operation and maintenance analysts, technicians, and/or engineers. Performs technical analysis of complex software, hardware, and transmission facility using various diagnostic tools in support of efficient network operations. Provides guidance/direction for engineering efforts and test and evaluation programs. Performs on-site engineering when required.
Operations/Technical Support Analyst	BA + 5	Supervises and administers computer operations; schedules machine time; directs data entry efforts; provides users with computer output; and supervises staff operations.
Operations/Technical Support Manager	BA + 7	Provides technical guidance for directing and monitoring information systems operations. Implements machine modifications to increase the capacity of the system. Directs compilation of records and reports concerning production, machine

		malfunctioning and maintenance.
Senior Operations/Technical Manager	BA + 10	Provides technical guidance for planning, directing, and monitoring information systems operations. Plans and recommends machine modifications or additional equipment to increase the capacity of the system. Prepares operational cost estimates for current and proposed projects. Evaluates vendor proposals for purchases of hardware. Directs compilation of records and reports concerning production, machine malfunctioning, and maintenance. Consults on organizational, procedural, and work-flow plans, methods, and procedures analysis. Analyzes the results of workflow plans, monitors the operating system(s) and recommends changes to improve processing and utilization.
Systems Solution Analyst I	BA + 5	Analyzes information requirements; consults with clients to identify and specify IT requirements; develops overall functions and systems requirements and specifications; prepares business cases for the application of IT solutions; defines systems scope and objectives; develops cost estimates for new or modified systems; ensures the integration of all systems components (e.g., procedures, databases, policies, software, and hardware); plans systems implementation; assists in establishing standards for information systems procedures; and develops and applies organization-wide information models.
Systems Solution Analyst II	BA + 10	Performs all the duties of Systems Analyst I and analyzes process and re-engineering with an understanding of technical problems and solutions as they relate to the current and future business environment. Creates process change by integrating new processes with existing ones and communicating these changes to impacted Systems teams. Recommends and facilitates quality improvement efforts. The analyst leads the development of business requirements, dimensional modeling, and OLA and query report development activities in an IT business intelligence development project.

Systems Solution Analyst III	BA + 15	Performs all the duties of Systems Analyst II and formulates and defines systems scope and objectives based on both user needs and a good understanding of applicable business systems and industry requirements. Devises or modifies procedures to solve complex problems considering computer equipment capacity and limitations, operating time, and form of desired results. Includes analysis of business and user needs, documentation of requirements, and translation into proper system requirement specifications. Guides and advises less-experienced Systems Analysts. Competent to work at the highest technical level of most phases of systems analysis while considering the business implications of the application of technology to the current and future business environment.
Journeyman Network Analyst I	BA + 1	The Journeyman Network Analyst I produce intelligence assessments for formal production and release. The analyst may be deployed throughout the theater of operation. This position is considered equivalent to the GS-09 level.
Journeyman Network Analyst II	BA + 3	The Journeyman Network Analyst II produces intelligence assessments for formal production and release. The analyst coordinates with the customer to gather additional information and share analytic conclusions. The analyst is capable of deployment throughout theater of operation. This position is considered equivalent to the GS-09 level.
Principal Network Analyst	BA + 10	The Principal Network Analyst (PNA) produces intelligence assessments for formal production and release. The analyst coordinates with the customer to gather additional information and share analytic conclusions. The analyst is capable of deployment throughout theater of operation. The analyst identifies new networks and targets on which to focus analytic efforts. The PNA coordinates all intelligence research and production activities of the team, coordinates and synchronizes activities of team members. The PNA conducts initial quality control of all team products. Contractor employees filling this position may be considered key personnel. This position is considered equivalent to the GS-12 level.

Senior Network Analyst I	BA + 7	The Senior Network Analyst I produce intelligence assessments for formal production and release. The analyst coordinates with the customer to gather additional information and share analytic conclusions. The analyst is capable of deployment throughout theater of operation. The analyst identifies new networks and targets on which to focus analytic efforts. This position is considered equivalent to the GS-11 level.
Senior Network Analyst II	BA + 9	The Senior Network Analyst II produces intelligence assessments for formal production and release. The analyst coordinates with the customer to gather additional information and share analytic conclusions. The analyst is capable of deployment throughout theater of operation. The Senior Analyst leads efforts to identify new devices, initiators, and TTP on which to focus analytic efforts. The analyst assists with the training and mentoring of Network Analysts. This position is considered equivalent to the GS-11/12 level.
