Shift Differentials: We use flat rates.

Work Week: Sunday – Saturday

Overtime Rate(s): same as hourly rate

Weeknight On-Call Rate(s): 1.25 x hourly rate

For example if hourly rate is \$ 100.00. Weeknight On-call rate is \$ 125.00 per night

Weekend On-Call rate: Hourly rate charged to the client (rate x 3 hours)

For example if hourly rate is \$ 100.00. Weekend On-call rate is \$300.00 per weekend day.

Holiday On-Call rate: Same as Weekend On- Call Rate. Effective only on federal holidays.

Call Back Rate(s): Standard hourly rate applies

On-call is defined as a professional being required to carry a pager to be available for consultation relative to specific specialty. While on-call the physician must remain within 30-mile radius of the facility that is being covered. On-call rates do not apply to a physician being required to be at or stay at a facility after hours. Telephone consultation to be included with no additional charge.

Call back is when the physician is required to physically be at the facility and/or see patients. Normal hourly rates shall apply.

Weeknight On-Call is defined as a 15.5 hour period (i.e., Monday-Friday 4:30p-8:00a). The weeknight on-call rate will apply.

Weekend On-Call rates defined as a 24-hour period either Saturday 8am – Sunday 8am or Sunday 8am – Monday 8am. The weekend On-Call rate will apply if a Physician is assigned to carry a pager to be available for consultation relative to specific specialty, to report to the facility and/or see patients on the weekend as described in the Statement of Work (i.e. Saturday 8am-Monday 8am).

Minimum Qualifications of Professionals:

Physicians, MD or DO who are board certified or as considered under ANA definition as board eligible by having completed a residency and having at least one year of experience in their respective specialty.

Advanced Practice Nurses: CRNA's, NP's are all masters prepared and board certified with at least one year of experience within the preceding 3 years. **Physician Assistants** are all graduates of an accredited program for Physician Assistants with at least one year of experience within the preceding 3 years.
