Shift Differentials:

Work Week: Sunday – Saturday

For Allied Healthcare Providers:

Overtime Rate(s): 1.3x the hourly rate for all hours worked in excess of 40 hours per work week. For California, 1.3x the normal hourly rate for all hours worked in excess of 8 hours and 1.8x the normal hourly rate for all hours worked in excess of 12 hours in any work day. Overtime is in accordance with state and local labor laws.

Holiday Rate(s): 1.3x the normal hourly rate for all Federal Holidays worked.

Weeknight/Weekend On-Call/Call Back Rate(s): \$10.00 per hour for the time the provider is on-call. On-call is to carry a phone or pager and be able to provide phone consultations. The provider must be within 30 minutes or 30 miles radius from the facility.

Call Back Rate(s): The normal hourly rate applies if less than 40 hours worked. In excess of 40 hours, overtime of 1.3x the normal hourly rate applies for each hour worked when call back and physically onsite at the facility. One hour minimum charge.

For Physicians:

No Overtime Rate(s): Physicians receive the normal hourly rate-straight pay.

Holiday Rate(s): The normal hourly rate – no overtime (straight pay)

Weeknight On-Call Rate(s): Weeknight is a one-time flat charge of one hour of the normal hourly rate for a 15.5 hour period. The physician must be able to carry a phone or pager and be able to provide phone consultation. The weeknight period is generally 4:30pm – 8:00am. Physician must be within 30 miles or 30 minute radius from the facility.

Weekend On-Call Rate(s): Weekend on-call is a one-time flat charge that equals 3 hours of the normal hourly rate for a 24 hour period. (Weekend On-Call is generally 8:00am-8:00am on Saturday and Sunday). Physician must be able to carry a phone or pager and be able to provide phone consultation. Physician must be within 30 miles or 30 minute radius from the facility.

Call Back Rate(s): If the physician must report to the facility and see patients, the normal rate applies when physically onsite for all hours worked. One hour minimum charge.
