Shift Differentials: Evening shift differential is 4%; Night shift differential is 6%; Weekend shift differential is 10%. Shift differentials apply to the base rate and are not cumulative. Physicians are not covered by the SCA.

Evening= defined as starting after 2pm

Night= defined as starting after 9pm

Weekends= defined as Saturday starting at 5am through Monday ending by 8am

Work Week: Sunday – Saturday

Overtime Rate(s): Overtime is paid 1.4 times the base rate for hours worked over 40 hours in a work week. For the State of California: 1.4 x base rate for all hours worked in excess of 8 hours in any workday, and for the first 8 hours worked on the 7th consecutive day of work in a workweek and 1.8 x base rate for all hours worked in excess of 12 hours in any workday and for all hours worked in excess of 8 hours on the 7th consecutive day of work in a workweek. Overtime payment does not apply to physicians.

Holiday Rate(s): Holiday is paid 1.4 times the base rate for all hours worked on federally observed Holidays. Employees will be paid Holiday pay only for the hours worked between midnight to midnight of the Holiday. Hours worked before or after the designated Holiday will be paid at the normal hourly rate. Holidays considered the full 24 hours - shifts that fall between midnight to midnight on the day of the Holiday

On-Call/Call Back Rate(s): For Physicians, NP, and PA: \$10/hr. For all others \$7.00/hr. Provider must be able to carry a beeper or cell phone and be able to provide phone consultation relative to their specialty and must be within a 30 miles or 30 minute radius of the facility.
