Must be a Medical Doctor (MD/DO) and be Board Certified or Board Eligible in their individual specialty(ies). All physicians provided under this contract will have successfully completed an Undergraduate Program, Medical School (MD or DO), Internship, and an Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education approved Residency Program. Maintain current Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) or Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) certification. Appropriate Physician experience will meet or exceed the needs of the individual ordering client/facility. All Physicians must be licensed in at least one State and in good standing.

621-003 Physician – Internal Medicine

Must be a Medical Doctor (MD/DO) and be Board Certified or Board Eligible in their individual specialty(ies). All physicians provided under this contract will have successfully completed an Undergraduate Program, Medical School (MD or DO), Internship, and an Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education approved Residency Program. Maintain current Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) or Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) certification. 621-004 Physician - Pediatrician

621-012 Physician – Optometrist

Doctor of Optometry (O.D.) from a 4-year school or college of optometry in the United States. 2 years' experience in the past 24 months in the specialty. Graduate of an Accreditation Council on Optometric Education (ACOE) College.

621-17 Physician – Psychiatrist

Physicians working in Psychiatry must have completed an undergraduate and medical school and receive the degree of MD or DO. For physicians who have completed medical school outside the U.S., the Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG) is required. All physicians must complete a Residency Training Program approved by the Accreditation Council of Graduate Medical Education (ACGME). The physicians must be board certified in Psychiatry by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology or the American Osteopathic Board of Neurology and Psychiatry. For a physician to be considered board eligible, they are within 1-4 years after the completion of their residency. All physicians will have a minimum of BLS and preferably ACLS certifications.

621-18 Psychologist

Current, active, valid, and unrestricted medical license from a U.S. State; must be board certified in appropriate specialty. Minimum two years' experience within the past three years in the area of practice. Degree in medicine from an accredited school of medicine.

621-25 Registered Nurse – General

RN's must have license verifiable through Board of Nurse Examiners and have at least one year experience in specialty in the last three years. RN's must have a minimum of associate degree in nursing.

621-25 Registered Nurse – Specialized

RN's must have license verifiable through Board of Nurse Examiners and have at least one year experience in specialty in the last three years. RN's must have a minimum of associate degree in nursing.

621-27 Pharmacist

Certification in specialty areas (geriatrics, etc.) is available but not required. License is state- based and all states use the NAPLEX exam or endorsement as the basis for licensure. Some states require a separate jurisprudence exam. Minimum twelve months experience in past 24. 2 years undergraduate pre-requisites plus 4 years of pharmacy school.

621-30 Physician Assistant

Must be certified by the NCCPA and licensed in one of the fifty states. They must be a graduate of an approved PA school. They also must maintain a current Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) certificate as well as a Basic Life Support (BLS) card. The provider must have a minimum of 12 months experience in the last 36 months.

621-31 Speech Therapist

C.E.U Certifications as required by state; BLS and/or ACLS required CPR certification required. Minimum one year of clinical experience. Master's degree in Speech Pathology from an accredited school.

621-32 EMT

EMT must have completed the required course requirement for the said state and have passed the state required examinations with a minimum of 1 year of experience. Levels of EMT – Basic, Intermediate (undergo an additional 65-80 hours of training), and Paramedics (undergo an additional 600-1000 hours of instruction including clinical and field internships). BCLS and ACLS if applicable.

621-33 Dental Assistant

The dental assistant shall possess a Certificate or Associate Degree as a dental assistant/technician from a state accredited program and 1 year experience within the previous 3 years OR certification from a military dental technician or dental assistant “A”. Membership in good standing with the American Association of Dental Assistants with required continuing education.

621-33 Dental Hygienist

Graduation from an ADA accredited dental hygiene program. Valid dental hygiene licensure from at least 1 US state. Minimum 1 year experience in the previous 3 years.

621-34 Respiratory Therapist

Graduation from an approved program in Respiratory Therapy. Must obtain registration/certification and state licensure as required. 1 year of experience in the previous 2 years. AARC certification, state licensure if required, BLS/ACLS.

621-35 Physical Therapist

Graduation from an accredited Physical Therapy Program. Minimum twelve months experience in past 24 months. All providers will have successfully completed the certification process. ACLS: Preferred BCLS: Required

621-37 Occupational Therapist

Graduation from an accredited Occupational Therapy Program. Minimum twelve months experience in past 24 months. All providers will have successfully completed the certification process. ACLS: Preferred BCLS: Required

621-38 Licensed Vocational Nurse

LVN’s must have license verifiable through Board of Vocational Nurse Examiners and have at least one year experience in the last three years. Must be certified in CPR, ACLS, PALS.

621-39 Medical Technician

Medical Assistants must be certified and have at least one year experience in a medical setting. Must be certified in CPR.

621-40 Certified Nursing Assistant

CNA’s must be certified and must have at least six months experience in a medical setting. Must be certified in CPR.

621-44 Ophthalmic Technician

Requires a two-year associate's degree. 1 year experience in the past 24 months in specialty Certified Optometric Technician.

621-44 Ophthalmic Technician - Lead

Requires a two-year associate's degree. 1 year experience in the past 24 months in specialty Certified Optometric Technician. Can supervise junior personnel.

621-46 Medical Laboratory Technician

Requires a two-year associate's degree. 1 year experience in the past 24 months in specialty. BLS required.

621-47 Mental Health Technician/Specialist

HS Diploma or equivalent required. Minimum of 1 year experience in field. BLS required.

621-47 Clinical Social Worker

Bachelor's Degree in Social Work. May possess current social work certification through the Academy of Certified Social Workers (ACSW). Requires 1-2 years of experience in the field or in a related area. Current unrestricted license in one US State or Territory.

621-48 Health & Fitness Specialist/Dietician

Bachelor's Degree in related field. Requires 1 year of experience in related field. Possesses current CPR certification.

621-050 Radiography – Diagnostic Imaging Technician

Registration through the American Registry of Radiology Technologists; BCLS, ACLS Specialty 1 year experience in the past 24 months in specialty. Graduate of an AMA approved school of Radiology, Nuclear Medicine, or Ultrasound.

621-050 Radiography – Radiology Technologist

Registration through the American Registry of Radiology Technologists; BCLS, ACLS Specialty 1 year experience in the past 24 months in specialty. Graduate of an AMA approved school of Radiology, Nuclear Medicine, or Ultrasound.

621-50 Radiography - Ultrasound Technician

Registration through the American Registry of Radiology Technologists; BCLS, ACLS Specialty 1 year experience in the past 24 months in specialty. Graduate of an AMA approved school of Radiology, Nuclear Medicine, or Ultrasound.

621-51 Pharmacy Technician

All technicians must be certified Pharmacy Technicians and have completed PhT course. Minimum 1 year experience in current setting.

621-054 Registered Nurse Practitioner

NP's must have RN license verifiable through Board of Nurse Examiners and have at least one year experience in specialty in the last three years. NP's must have a minimum of master's degree. Must be certified in CPR, ACLS, PALS.

621-056 Clinical Technician

Possesses HS Diploma or equivalent. Must have completed an accredited training program in the required specialty. Minimum 1 year of professional experience. BCLS: Required

621-057 Chiropractor

Must be a graduate of a chiropractic college accredited by the Council on Chiropractic Education or its successor. Current valid unrestricted license in one US state or territory. ACLS: Preferred.
