Work Week: Sunday – Saturday

Overtime Rate(s):

SIN 025: Overtime is time and a third (1.3 x hourly rate) after a 40 hour work week.

CA: Overtime is 1.3 x between the 9th – 12th hour worked.

Overtime is 1.7 x the normal hourly rate over the 12th hour worked.

Overtime is applicable to SIN 025. Physicians, Physicists and Dosimetrists receive the normal hourly rate.

Holiday Rate(s): SIN 025: Holiday rate is paid at 1.3 x the hourly rate when worked. Holiday rates do not apply to non-SCA covered positions.

On-Call Rate(s):

On-Call: 621-003, 009, 020 = Evening/Night \$150.

Weekends = \$500 and includes two (2) hours of call-back services.

Weekends begin on Friday at 5:00 PM and continue through Monday morning, depending on department hours (72 hrs).

On-Call: 612-025 = \$5.00 per hour for a 16 hour period. On-call includes telephone consultations. For all SINS: When in “on-call” status, the individual is required to carry a beeper or cell phone and answer calls. The individual must be within 30 minutes from the facility or within a 30 mile radius as determined by the task ordering facility. When they are called back to work and out of “on-call” status, their normal hourly rate applies.

Call Back Rate(s): Call-Back: Minimum is 1 hour pay. If the placement is called back to the medical facility, the regular hourly base rate (Task Order) will be charged unless overtime is incurred due to 40 hours already worked. Overtime rate is charged at the overtime rate for hours the placement worked. Vendor call back rates will apply once individual is physically on-site.
