15. Warranty provision: Leica's standard, commercial warranty is one year.

Leica warrants to Buyer that the Leica products to be delivered hereunder will (i) be free from defects in material, manufacturing workmanship, and title, and (ii) conform to Leica's applicable product descriptions and specifications, if any contained in or attached to Leica's quotation. If no product descriptions or specifications are contained in or attached to the quotation, Leica's applicable product descriptions and specifications in effect on the date of shipment shall apply. The criteria for all testing shall be Leica's applicable product specifications utilizing factory-specified calibration and test procedures and instruments.

Any product or part furnished without charge to Buyer during the warranty period to correct a warranty failure shall be warranted to the extent of the unexpired term of the warranty applicable to the repaired or replaced product.

The warranty period shall commence on the date the product is delivered to Buyer; however, if Leica assembles the product, or provides technical direction of such assembly, the warranty period for such product shall commence on the date the assembly of the product is complete. In the event that the assembly of the product is substantially complete, and the customer utilizes the product on an ongoing basis to perform beneficial research or production work, the system warranty start date shall be the date of the commencement of such beneficial customer use of the product, even if certain components, options or accessories included in the order are scheduled for later delivery. The warranty period for any such components, options or accessories delivered after commencement of the system warranty period above shall begin on the date of the completion of the installation of these items.

The one (1) year warranty included any travel, labor, and parts related to the repair of said instrument excluding any consumable items, all consumable replacements are the responsibility of the customer, and will only be covered under the warranty if the consumables were missing from the initial product installation. Warranty will be null and void if any party other than a Leica Authorized Service Engineer attempts repair of said instrument(s) during the one (1) year warranty period.



WARRANTY EXCLUSIONS

Warranty coverage does not include any defect or performance deficiency (including failure to conform to product descriptions or specifications) which results, in whole or in part, from (1) negligent storage or handling of the product by Buyer, its employees, agents, or contractors, (2) failure of Buyer to prepare or maintain the site or provide power requirements or operation environmental condition in compliance with any applicable instructions or recommendations of Leica, (3) adverse power conditions or environmental conditions such as erratic power, voltage spikes, RF or magnetic interference, HVAC failure or other causes beyond the reasonable control of the Leica, (4) absence of any product, component, or accessory recommended by Leica but omitted or removed at Buyer's direction, (5) any design, specification, or instruction furnished by Buyer, its employees, agents, or contractors, (6) any alteration of the product by persons other than Leica, (7) combining Leica's product with any product furnished by others where such combination causes failure of or degradation to performance of Leica's product, (8) combining incompatible products of Leica, (9) improper or extraordinary use of the product, improper maintenance of the product, or failure to comply with any applicable instructions or recommendations of Leica, or (10) acts of God, acts of civil or military authority, fires, floods, strikes or other labor disturbances, war, riot, or other causes beyond the reasonable control of the Leica. Leica does not warrant products of others which are not included in Leica's published product catalog.

BUYER'S REMEDIES

If Leica determines that any product fails to meet any warranty during the applicable warranty period, Leica shall correct any such failure by either, at its option, repairing, adjusting, or replacing without charge to Buyer any defective or nonconforming product, or part or parts of the product. Leica shall have the option to furnish either new or exchange replacement parts or assemblies.

The place of performance for work under warranty shall be the nearest Authorized Service Center. For products forming part of a fixed installation, it shall be the site of such installation. The Leica at its sole discretion shall decide the place of performance.

Warranty service during the applicable warranty period will be performed without charge to Buyer during Leica's normal business hours. While every effort will be made to render services promptly, this does not include any guarantees of specific response time or uptime, which may be available for purchase under separate contract. Subject to the availability of personnel after-hours service is available upon request at an additional charge.

The remedies set forth herein are condition upon Buyer promptly notifying Leica within the applicable warranty period of any defect or nonconformance and making the product available for correction at a mutually agreed-upon time.
