Terms for On-Call: Rates applies when a personnel is required to be available by phone or pager and be able to provide phone consultation. Personnel must be within a 30 mile or 30 minute radius from the facility.

Weeknight On-Call: Flat rate of 1.25x regular hourly rate; Monday through Friday 4:30pm-8:00am. If called back into the facility, paid the regular hourly rate for the time worked, minimum of 1 hour.

Weekends/ Holidays On-Call: Flat rate of 4x regularly hourly rate for a 24-hour period; Saturday & Sunday 8:00am-8:00am. If called back into the facility, paid the regular hourly rate for the time worked, minimum of 1 hour.

Call-back: Begins when personnel are physically at work site.

**Non-Physicians:**

Overtime: Regular hourly rate x 1.1 for all hours worked in excess of 8 hours/day or 40 hours/week.

Holidays: Regular hourly rate x 1.1.

Terms for On-Call: Rates applies when a personnel is required to be available by phone or pager and be able to provide phone consultation. Personnel must be within a 30 mile or 30 minute radius from the facility.

Weeknight/Weekend/Holiday On-Call: \$10 per hour on call. If called back into the facility, paid at the regular hourly rate for the time worked, minimum of 1 hour; overtime rate applies if over 40 hrs/wk.

Call-back: Begins when personnel are physically at work site.

## Minimum Qualification of Professionals

### **Experience:**

Physicians will hold at least one full and unrestricted professional license in a State, Territory, or Commonwealth of the United States or District of Columbia.

Non-Physicians: National Certification, or certified by their individual states board. Will have successfully completed the undergraduate or graduate degrees. Non-physicians will hold at least one full and unrestricted professional license in a State, Territory, or Commonwealth of the United States or District of Columbia.

### **Certifications:**

All individuals performing services under the terms of this contract shall hold current certification in Basic Cardiac Life Support (BLS) and/or Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) as required.
