
Workweek – Sunday - Monday

Overtime – Overtime rates apply after an 8-hour shift or 40 hours per week has been completed.

Overtime Rate – Flat rate

Holiday Rate – 1.5x Base Rate

Weekend/Holiday Call Rate: Rate is ½ of the base daily rate.



SHIFT DIFFERENTIALS

On –call Terms – Healthcare professional who is assigned to carry a pager to be available for phone consultations relative to a specific specialty, and must be within 45 minutes of the facility. Healthcare professional who is on-call will be paid at the on-call rate. The on-call rate is only for the healthcare professional to carry the pager, provide phone consultation, and be available to report to the facility and/or see patients. Once the healthcare professional is called into the facility, overtime rates apply for all hour that is required to remain at the facility. **Except Weekend call for SIN 017 which includes 2 hours of on-site performance.**

Weeknight Call – Weeknight call rates will apply if a healthcare professional is required to carry a pager to be available for phone consultations relative to a specific specialty, report to the facility and/or see patients after normal hours (i.e. Monday – Friday 7:00am – 4:30pm.)

Weeknight Call Hours and Rate: M-F between the hours of 4:30pm-7:30am – Flat rate of 1 hour over time.

Weekend call – Weekend on-call is defined as a 24-hour period from either Saturday at 7:30am – Sunday at 7:30am or Sunday 7:30am – Monday at 7:30am. The weekend call rate shall apply if a healthcare professional is required to carry a pager, provide phone consultation, and requested to report to the facility and /or see patients. . Once the healthcare professional is called into the facility, overtime rates apply for all hour that is required to remain at the facility. **Except Weekend call for SIN 017 which includes 2 hours of on-site performance.**






