Work Week: Sunday – Saturday

Overtime Rate(s): 120% beginning with the 41st hour per week consistent with state and local labor laws.

Holiday Rate(s): 1.2 x normal hourly rate for hours worked on federally recognized holidays.

On-Call Rate(s): \$5.00/hour. Healthcare Professionals on call must remain within a 30 mile radius of the facility they are on call to. Healthcare professionals must carry a pager, beeper, cell phone or be by a phone for the period they are on call.

Call Back Rates(s): Call- Back is billed at regular rates unless the healthcare professional has reached 41 hours worked in a week in which overtime charges of 120% will apply. Call back charges apply if on call healthcare professional is called back to the facility. Call back charges start at the time healthcare professional starts call back shift.
