Overtime Rate: (Allied Healthcare Providers only) 1.3x the normal hourly rate.

Overtime: (Allied Healthcare Providers only) Excess of 40 hrs per week per State and labor laws. California 1.3x the normal hourly rate after the first 8 hours then 1.8x the hourly rate after 12 hrs.

Double Time: (Allied Healthcare Providers only) 1.8x the normal hourly rate after 12 hours of work in a day in accordance with State and local laws.

Holiday Pay Rate 1.3x the normal hourly rate for all Government Holidays.

Workweek: Sunday through Saturday

Allied Healthcare Providers:

On Call: \$6.00 per hour rate for time provider is on call. On call is to carry a beeper. The provider must be within 30 minutes of the facility or within an approved radius from the facility.

Call Back: Overtime will be charged for each hour worked when the provider is called back, with a minimum charge of two (2) hours.

Locum Tenens Physicians:

Physicians- Weeknight On-Call: One time flat charge equals 1 hour @ ½ (one-half) the normal hourly rate. Physician must carry a beeper or cell phone and be able to provide phone consultation. Physician must be within a 30 minute radius of the facility. The weeknight On-Call period is generally 4:30pm-8:00 am. If the Physician must report to the facility and see patients, then the normal hourly rate for the actual hours worked will be charged with a 2 hour minimum.

Weekend On-Call/Call Back: One Flat Charge for a 48 hour period (Saturday & Sunday). Weekend period is 8:00 am – 8:00 am. Physician is to carry a beeper, answer calls and remain within 30 minutes of the facility during any weekend, which includes the days of Saturday & Sunday. Weekend periods (including Saturday & Sunday) will include a one time charge equal to 3 hours at the normal hourly rate with the exception of all Anesthesiologists who will get 4 hours at the normal hourly rate. If the Physician must report to the facility and see patients, then the normal hourly rate for the actual hours worked will be charged with a 2 hour minimum.

HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONAL MINIMUM QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

MD/DO - Physician – (SIN 621-001) – Must be a Medical Doctor (M.D./D.O.) and be Board Certified by the American Board or Board Eligible in their individual specialty(ies). All physicians provided under this contract will have successfully completed an Undergraduate Program, Medical School (MD or DO), Internship, and a complete Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) approved Residency Program. Must maintain appropriate unrestricted licensure in the client/facility State or the State where assigned. Maintain current Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) or Advanced Cardiac life Support (ACLS) certification. Appropriate Physician experience will meet or exceed the needs of the individual ordering client/facility. All Physicians must be Board licensed/eligible in at least one State and in good standing with no pending litigations against them.

Anesthesiologist – (SIN 621-006) – Must be a Medical Doctor (M.D./D.O.). Must maintain appropriate unrestricted licensure in the client/facility State or the State where assigned. Appropriate Anesthesiology experience will meet or exceed the needs of the individual ordering client/facility. Maintain current Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) or Advanced Cardiac life Support (ACLS) certification. Shall be approved for membership and/or clinical privileges on the medical staff in accordance with client/facility medical staff Bylaws and Rules and Regulations. All Anesthesiologists must be Board licensed/eligible in at least one State and in good standing with no pending litigations against them.

Psychiatrist – (SIN 621-017) – Must be a Medical Doctor (M.D./D.O.) and be Board Certified by the American Board or Board Eligible within their individual specialty(ies). Must maintain appropriate unrestricted licensure in the client/facility State or the State where assigned. Maintain current Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) or Advanced Cardiac life Support (ACLS) certification. Appropriate Psychiatrist experience will meet or exceed the needs of the individual ordering client/facility. All Psychiatrists must be Board licensed/eligible in at least one State and in good standing with no pending litigations against them.

Psychologist – (SIN 621-018) – Must have a Bachelors, Masters, or PHD from an Accredited College with an emphasis in Psychology. Clinical and counseling psychologists require a Doctorate in Psychology, completion of an approved internship, and 1 to 2 years of professional experience. Proof of passing the required State examination, licensing board administered standardized test, and any other oral or essay questioning required by the State. Provide proof of continuing education for license renewal as required by the State. The American Psychological Association (APA) accreditation doctoral training programs in clinical, counseling, and school psychology is preferred as well as the American Board of Professional Psychology (ABPP) recognizing the professional achievement providing proof of an award or specialty certification in

clinical psychology, clinical neuro-psychology, and counseling, forensic, industrial-organizational, and school psychology. Must have a current and valid license issued by the appropriate State Board of Psychology. Must ensure and maintain all appropriate licenses, permits, certifications and other requirements current and in effect at all times during the term of contracted work. All Psychologists must be Board licensed/eligible in at least one State and in good standing with no pending litigations against them.

RN - Registered Nurse – (SIN 621-025)

Description: Practice of safe and ethical nursing care within the scope of his/her profession as defined by the State Nursing Practice Act, understanding his/her limitations, seeking advice and assistance when necessary.

Education: Graduate of an Accredited Registered Nurse program. BSN Degree preferred.

Experience: Active RN Practice License with at least one (1) year of current clinical experience within the last three (3) years rendering patient or nursing care within their specialty.

Certifications: Current CPR Certification, current ACLS/BCLS. Infectious Disease Certificate (TB Test/X-Ray).

DDS - Dentist – (SIN 621-026) – Must be a Medical Doctor (M.D./D.O.) and be Board Certified by the American Board or Board Eligible in their individual Dentist specialty(ies). Must maintain appropriate unrestricted licensure in the client/facility State or the State where assigned. Must provide proof of an ADA Accredited Degree and proof of passing the State Licensure Exam, which substantiates the Clinical examination requirements. All American graduates with a DDS/DMD degree and who qualify for the State licensure examination (through their accredited qualifications) are acceptable. Must provide proof of passing the written examination requirement met by the NDB Exam Parts 1 and 2. Must possess and maintain throughout the term of contracted work, certification from the appropriate State Department of Consumer Affairs - Dental Board, a registered Dental license. All Dentists must be Board licensed/eligible in at least one State and in good standing with no pending litigations against them.

LP/VN - Licensed Practical/Vocational Nurse – (SIN 621-038)

Description: Must practice safe and ethical nursing care within the scope of his/her profession as defined by the Nursing Practice Act, with the understanding of his/her own limitations, while seeking advice and assistance when necessary.

Education: Graduate of an Accredited School of Nursing with emphasis in Licensed Practical/Vocational Nurse programs and a minimum of an Associates Degree or Diploma.

Experience: Active LP/VN License and at least 12 months of experience in the previous 24 months with excellent supervisory and professional references.

Certifications: Current CPR certification (BCLS/ACLS). Must ensure and maintain all appropriate licenses, permits, certifications and other requirements current and in effect at all times during the term of contracted work.

LCSW – Licensed Clinical Social Worker – (SIN 621-047)

Description: Counsels individuals or groups regarding psychological or emotional problems, such as stress, substance abuse, or family situations, using evaluative techniques, and develops and implements therapeutic treatment plan in a medical setting. Interviews patient to obtain information concerning medical history or other pertinent

information. Observes client to detect indications of abnormal physical or mental behavior. Plans and administers therapeutic treatment, such as behavior modification and stress management therapy to assist patient in controlling disorders and other problems. Discusses progress toward goals with clients, and consults with medical doctor or other specialists concerning treatment plan and amends plan as directed.

Education: Must hold a Masters Degree in Human Services, Social Work or related field.

Experience: Must have an active Practice License issued by the appropriate State Board of Behavioral Sciences and at least 24 months or experience in the previous 36 months.

Certifications: Must ensure and maintain all appropriate licenses, permits, certifications and other requirements current and in effect at all times during the term of the contract.
