The on-call rate will be paid only for the healthcare professional to carry the pager, provide phone consultation, and be available to report to the facility and/or see patients. Once the healthcare professional is called into the facility, Regular hourly wage (1-minimum) if called into the facility. One half the regular daily rate will apply for Saturday and Sunday on-call availability, applicable to a 24-hour period, and a minimum bill rate of one hour for overnight.
