Responsibilities:	Operates X-ray equipment and performs various mammography related procedures. Develops and evaluates the film for technical quality such as density contrast, definition, and distortion. Explains procedures and educates women about the role of regular mammography in preventive breast health. Responsibilities also include preparing and maintaining records and files, and cleaning and adjusting equipment as needed. Familiar with standard concepts, practices, and procedures within this field. Relies on experience and judgment to plan and accomplish goals. Performs a variety of tasks.
