Workweek: Sunday (12:00am) through Saturday (11:59pm)

Overtime: 1.4x the hourly rate for all hours worked in excess of 8 or 12 hours/day or 40 per week or as required by state, local and/or federal law . Double time will be billed at the rate of 1.7x the hourly rate. Overtime does not apply to physicians

Shift Differentials: None

On-Call: For Allied Health Service Personnel only. On-call is \$6/hour and provider will carry a pager or cell phone and be within 30 minutes or 30 miles of the facility. Phone consultation is not included.

Call-Back: Call back is at the applicable hourly rate when the provider arrives on site. Over 40 hours/week or 8 hours/day is the negotiated Overtime rate. Minimum assignment is 1 hour.

Holidays: 1.4 times the hourly rate for holidays worked and recognized by the federal government.

Background Investigations: Insures that all licensures and certifications are current according to individual state requirements.
