All nuclear medicine technologists must meet the minimum Federal standards on the administration of radioactive drugs and the operation of radiation detection equipment

Health Screenings

- Annual medical evaluation and statement of satisfactory health status
- Annual tuberculin testing with negative results, or positive tuberculin test result with negative chest X-ray
- Evidence of immunity to rubella (antibody titer or vaccine) or immunity to MMR, as requested by client
- Evidence of immunity to varicella or statement of history of chicken pox
- Hepatitis B vaccination, antibody titre or signed declination
- May require annual influenza immunization or signed declination
- 10-panel drug screen clearance in compliance with TGI's alcohol and drug free workplace policy

Administrative Standards

- Completed 1-9 documentation demonstrating (copies of supporting documents) eligibility to work in U.S.

- Signed acknowledgements evidencing receipt of information regarding patient confidentiality and privacy, abuse and neglect recognition and reporting, professional accountability and conduct.
