Overtime Rate(s): Regular Hours Apply

Holiday Rate(s): All Physicians required to work during the 10 Federal Holidays will be compensated at their usual hourly rate.

On-Call Rate(s): Weeknight On-Call for Physician received one time charge to wear pager, answer calls, and remain within 30 minutes of the facility. The normal hourly rate applies for the actual hours present with a 1-hour minimum. Weeknight On-Call period is generally 4:30- 8:00 am. Weeknight On-Call one time charge equals hourly rate.

Weekend On-Call receive the 24 hour weekend On-Call one time charge to wear pager, answer calls, and remain within 30 minutes of the facility during any weekend 24 hour period. The normal hourly rate applies for the actual hours present with a 1 hour minimum. Weekend On-Call period is generally 8:00 am to 8:00 am. Weekend 24 hour On-Call one time charge equals 3 hours of the hourly rate for all physicians.

Call Back Rate(s): Regular rates apply for Call-Back and Call-Back applies when physically on site.

Minimum Qualifications of Professionals: Below is the description of qualifications for each labor category that GMS is interested in working with.

SIN 621-001 General and Family Practice description: Physicians working in General and Family Practice must have completed an undergraduate and medical school and received the degree of MD or DO. For physicians who have completed medical school outside the U.S., the Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG) is required. All physicians must complete a Residency Training Program approved by the Accreditation Council of Graduate Medical Education (ACGME). The physicians must be board certified in Family Practice by the American Board of Family Medicine or the American College of Osteopathic Family Physicians. For the physician to be considered board eligible, they are within 1-4 years after the completion of their residency. All physicians will have a minimum of BLS and preferably ACLS certifications.

SIN 621-002 Emergency Medicine: Trauma Level I description: Physicians working in Emergency Medicine must have completed an undergraduate and medical school and received the degree of MD or DO. For physicians who have completed medical school outside the U.S., the Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG) is required. All physicians must complete a Residency Training Program approved by the Accreditation Council of Graduate Medical Education (ACGME). The physicians must be board certified in Emergency Medicine by the American Board of Emergency Medicine, American Board of Physician Specialties, or the American Osteopathic Board of Emergency Medicine. For a physician to be considered board eligible, they are within 1-4 years after the completion of their residency. On some occasions, physicians who are trained and board certified in primary care specialty and have emergency Medicine experience in the last two (2) years may be considered for Emergency Medicine positions. All physicians will have a minimum of BLS and ACLS, preferably ATLS and PALS certifications.

SIN 621-003 Hospitalist description: Physicians working in Hospitalist must have completed an undergraduate and medical school and received the degree of MD or DO. For physicians who have completed medical school outside the U.S., the Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG) is required. All physicians must complete a Residency Training Program approved by the Accreditation Council of Graduate Medical Education (ACGME). The physicians must be board certified

in Internal Medicine by the American Board of Internal Medicine of the American Osteopathic Board of Internal Medicine. For a physician to be considered board eligible, they are within 1-4 years after the completion of their residency. The physician must have a minimum of one (1) year of Hospitalist experience (training program does apply). All physicians will have a minimum of BLS and ACLS certifications.

SIN 621-017 Psychiatry: General Adult, Geriatric description: Physicians working in Psychiatry must have completed undergraduate and medical school and received the degree of MD or DO. For physicians who have completed medical school outside the U.S., the Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG) is required. All physicians must complete a Residency Training Program approved by the Accreditation Council of Graduate Medical Education (ACGME). The physicians must be board certified in Psychiatry by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology of the American **Osteopathic Board of Neurology and Psychiatry**. For a physician to be considered board eligible, they are within 1-4 years after the completion of their residency. All physicians will have a minimum of BLS and Preferably ACLS certifications.
